Buel, thence cutting across the corner of a street and into the land of J. L. This day the Board of Commissioners of Madison County, met in regular session. The following members present, A. C. Millikin, M. L. Key, and James Withrow, and the Auditor of said County having on March 15th 1893 delivered to said Board a copy of the Petitions filed by E. A. Blaugher & others for the location and filling of a ditch filed with said Auditor on the 13th day of March A. S. 1893, on the following route & termini, to wit:

Commencing at a stake and corner to Mrs. W. Withrow & E. Blaugher's land, thence crossing Midway Pike in a south easterly direction, passing through the land of Johnson V. L. Buck, thence cutting across the corner of a street and into the land of John C. Jones to a point in an old open ditch about 30 rods from said Jones' west line, or on any other route that will give same best fits to said lands and also with a lateral starting in the street near V. L. Buck's line and running south west across the pike to the corner of J. T. Leamer's lot with six inch tile if the viewers think it necessary. And it appearing to said Board that the said petitioners have given bond conditioned according to law, duly approved by the Auditor of said County, the Board of Commissioners A. C. Millikin, M. L. To the Honorable, the Board of Commissioners of Madison County, Ohio.

The undersigned Engineer, in obedience to the directions of your Honorable Body, made on the 27th day of March A. S. 1893, has proceeded in the above matter, and has made a level and survey of the line of said proposed ditch improvement, and set stakes at every hundred feet numbering down stream; and have made a note of the intersections of lines and boundaries of lands, townships and county lines, land marks, bench marks and road and railroad crossings; and herewith make report of the same, with profile, ^{and} plat and an estimate of the number of cubic yards of earth or other substance to be removed, and the cost per cubic yard for each working section on said report indicated and of each section of one hundred feet.

I have also made, and return herewith, a schedule of all the lots and lands, and public and corporate roads, and railroads, together with the name of the owners, of such railroad companies, and the names of the lessees operating the same, that will be benefitted by said improvement; and an apportionment of the cost of locations ^{and} constructions, in money, to each lot & tract of land, road & railroad, according to the benefit which will result to each from the said improvement, and a specification of the manner in which the improvement shall be made and completed; the number of flood gates, waterways, fence crossings and bridges, including kinds ^{and} dimensions thereof; and such other matters as the undersigned deems important. The said survey level report and schedules are hereto attached and made a part thereof. 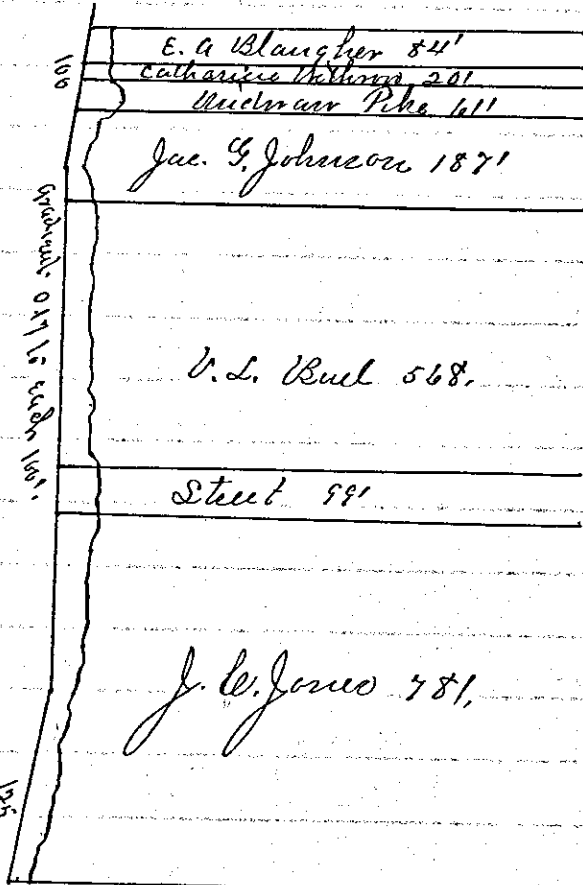

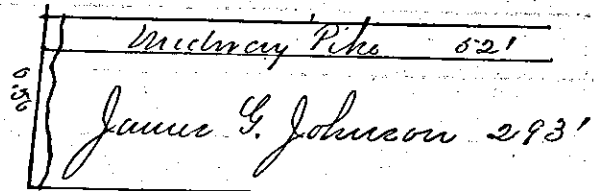

The within ditch must be uniformly and regularly graded from the stations to stations, conforming to the gradients shown on the profiles hereto attached.

The main ditch must have a six inch tile from stations 0 to stations 3, at seven inch tile from stations 3 to stations 9+40 and an eight inch tile from stations 9+40 to the terminus at stations 18.

Lateral 1. must have a 5 inch tile.

All tile must be round, evenly and uniformly burned, and first class in every respect and in no case must a warped or cracked tile be used, except in turning a curve in said ditch.

The trenches for the tile must be made wide enough to allow at least $1\frac{1}{2}$ inches running on each side and no part of the tile must be covered until the same has been examined by the Engineer in charge.

The price per cubic yard for excavations includes the cutting of the trenches, laying the tile and filling the trenches.

The estimated cost of the tile includes the cost at the factory, the hauling, ^{and} distributing the same along the banks of the ditch ^{and} the furnishing of suitable ^{up} or connections for any laterals to be constructed and for those already constructed.

All green trees, saplings, or bushes standing nearer than twenty feet of the center line of said ditches must be deadened or destroyed to prevent their roots from entering ^{and} obstructing the tile.

The cost of all labor above specified will be included in the contract prices and no part of the work will be accepted as completed until all the above requirements have been made.
