The Board having previously adjourned the view of said ditch to Friday, Nov. 29th 1895, (the route of which is described on page 318 of this Journal (Vol. 5.) as petitioned for) the Board accordingly met on the line of said improvement, and being satisfied that all interested parties had been notified of such hearing, proceeded to view the line of said proposed improvement, and the premises along and adjacent thereto.

After hearing the evidence and duly considering the matter, the Board find that said improvement is necessary and will be conducive to the public health, convenience and welfare, and order the beginning of the upper terminus to be about thirty rods south of the beginning mentioned in said petition, and order the County Surveyor to survey and level the same, below the lower terminus mentioned in the petition, and if necessary continue the same far enough down to give a good and sufficient outlet to all drainage above.

It is therefore ordered that H. L. Mc Cafferty, County Surveyor, go upon the line of said improvement, and survey and level the same and set a stake at every one hundred (100) feet running down stream, note the intersection of lines and boundaries of lands, township lines, land marks, bench marks, road and farm crossings and make a report, profile and plat of the same, and estimate the number of cubic yards of earth and other substance to be removed, and the cost per cubic yard of each working section of one hundred feet.

It is also directed that the County Surveyor make and return a schedule of all lots and lands and public and corporate roads, that will be benefited by said improvement, with an apportionment of the cost of location, and labor of construction in money, according to the benefits which will result to each, and a specification of the manner in which the improvement shall be made and completed, the number of floodgates, waterways, farm crossings and bridges necessary.

Said Engineer shall report his proceedings to the Board on Tuesday, Dec. 17th 1895 at 10 o'clock A. M. at the office of the Board in London Ohio, and all interested parties were notified accordingly.

To the Honorable Board of Commissioners of Madison
County, Ohio;

The undersigned Engineer, in obedience to the direction of your Honorable Body, made on the 2nd day of December, A. D. 1895, has proceeded in the above matter, and has made a level and survey of the line of said proposed ditch improvement, and set a stake at every hundred feet numbering down stream; and I have made a note of the intersection of lines and boundaries of lands, township and county lines, land marks, bench marks, and road and rail road crossings; and I herewith make report of the same, with profile, and plat and an estimate of the number of cubic yards of earth or other substance to be removed, and the cost per cubic yard for each working section in said report indicated and of each section of one hundred feet.

I have also made, and return herewith, a schedule of all lots and lands, and public and corporate roads and railroads, together with the owners of such railroad companies, and the names of the lessees operating the same, that will be benefited by said improvement; and an apportionment of the cost of location and construction, in money, to each lot and tract of land, road and railroad, according to the benefit which will result to each from the said improvement, and a specification of the manner in which the improvement shall be made and completed, the number of flood-gates, water-ways, farm crossings and bridges, including kinds and dimensions thereof; and such other matters as the undersigned deems important. The said survey, level report and schedules are herewith attached and made a part thereof.

The main ditch is to be made an open ditch from Station 0 to Station 69- 2 feet wide in the bottom with banks of cut sloped $1\frac{1}{2}$ to 1.
