This day the Board of Commissioners of Madison County, Ohio met in regular session. Members present A. W. Loofbourron, A. L. Millikin & M. L. Rea.

In the matter of the Road Improvement } Petition & Bond filed
Petitioned for by A. W. Wilson & others } Viewers & Engr. appointed

A petition signed by A. W. Wilson & Ninety seven (97) other land holders, whose lands will be accessed for the expense of the improvement mentioned below, was this day presented to the Board of Commissioners of Madison County, Ohio, praying for the establishment & improvement under the Two Mile Assessment Pike Law of Ohio, of a road by grading, graveling & claiming the same of a road along the following described route.

Beginning at a stake in the improved road known as the Middle Pike and in the line between the lands of John S. Wilson & Wm M. Wilson in Leaman township, Madison County, Ohio & thence running with said line, and a line between the lands of said Wm M. Wilson & D. H. Wilson to the west line of said Wm M. Wilson's land; thence in a direct course through the lands of said D. H. Wilson & A. W. Wilson's land to the angle in the old road a little east of the residence of A. W. Wilson, from said angle in the old road a little east of the residence of said A. W. Wilson aforesaid & running thence with said old road to where the same terminates in the improved road known as the Wilson & Whiget pike.

A good and sufficient bond signed by A. W. Wilson in the sum of two hundred (\$200.00) Dollars with Henry C. Wilson & Seter Bidwell sureties thereon conditioned according to law, has also been filed with said Board, thereupon said Board appointed Stephen Smith, F. M. Kearney & Henry Sully three disinterested free-holders of the County, as viewers & Elias Wilson as Surveyor or Engineer & direct them to meet at the residence of John S. Wilson on Monday the 25th day of April 1892 at 10 o'clock A.M. & after being duly sworn to take to their assistance two suitable persons as chain carriers & one marker and proceed to view, examine layout, or straighten said road as in their opinions public utility & convenience require; to access & determine the damages sustained by any person through whose premises the road is proposed to be laid out, straightened or improved; and to do such other things in the premises as are required of them by law, and to make a report of their proceedings in writing to this Board at its regular session on Monday the 9th day of May 1892 at 10 o'clock A.M.

The Auditor is directed to give notice as required by law in such case.

This day the Board of Commissioners of Madison County, met in Regular session pursuant to adjournment of May 8th 1882. Members present. O. W. Lofbourn, A. C. Millikin ^{and} M. L. Rea.

In the matter of the new road ^{and} improvement thereof in connection with a part of the old road, petitioned for by A. W. Wilson ^{and} others in Cassaca Township Madison County, Ohio } Improvement ordered
Engineers ^{and} apportioning
Committee appointed

This day the report of the viewers ^{and} engineers heretofore appointed on the new road ^{and} improvement thereof in connection with the old road petitioned for by A. W. Wilson ^{and} others came in for hearing as per adjournment of May 8th 1882.

The Commissioners thereupon proceeded to examine said report, and the petitioners for the location of a new road ^{and} the improvement of the same in connection with the old road mentioned in the petition, commonly known as the Columbus ^{and} Mechanicsburg road, and the said reports showing that there is a public necessity for the location ^{and} improvement of said new road, and the improvement of said old road as provided for in the petition, and the said reports being otherwise in conformity to law, the Commissioners proceeded to ascertain ^{and} determine if the petitioners for said road improvement were duly signed by the required number of petitioners and after examining the petitions and lands reported to be assessed for the expense of said road, and the improvement aforesaid; and having heard the evidence of disinterested witnesses, the Commissioners have of the opinion that the petition for said road ^{and} improvement is subscribed by a large majority of the resident land owners of the County, whose lands are reported benefited and ought to be assessed therefor. It is therefore ordered by the Commissioners that said new road

be and the same is hereby established and it is also ordered that said new road ^{and} the old road above mentioned, be improved, as prayed for in the petition and as specified in the report of said viewers ^{and} engineers to wit: the said road shall be opened to the width of 50 ft. including both the new and old parts of said improvement, the road bed shall be twenty eight (28) feet wide, the gravel to be twelve (12) feet wide on the north side of said road bed and two (2) feet from edge of road bed, the gravel to be 14 inches in center road and twelve (12) inches at outer edges.

The lands reported by said viewers ^{and} engineers shall be assessed for the expense of said road ^{and} improvement including the compensation ^{and} damages allowed by said viewers ^{and} engineers.

The board therefore order the reports ^{and} plat in said matter to be duly recorded and filed.

The Commissioners hereby appoint Elmer Moore, County Surveyor of Madison County, Ohio, a competent Engineer to superintend the performance ^{and} completion of the work of locating ^{and} improving said road.

The said Elmer Moore shall with the approval of the County Commissioners make a contract or contracts for the performance of said road work ^{and} he is hereby directed to do and perform all things required by him by the Statutes in such case made ^{and} provided.

Payments for said work will be made in cash, and for the purpose of raising money necessary to pay for said improvement,

It is ordered that Bonds of the County be issued of as near equal amounts as practicable due at intervals of six (6) months, for the period of five (5) years, said bonds to bear interest at the rate of six (6) percent per annum payable semi-annually.

Bonds ^{and} interest payable at the County Treasurer's Office of Madison County, Ohio, ^{and} the proper assessment be placed upon the road duplicate as provided by law.

The Board find that the following lands will be benefitted by said improvement and should be assessed to pay for same to wit:

In making said appportionment they shall take into consideration all previous special assessments, or special taxes made upon such real estate for the improvement of any road, and any benefit which will accrue to land by drainage resulting from the making of said improvement. And if any land to be assessed are subject to a life estate, the assessment shall be apportioned between the owners of the life estate and the owners of the fee in proportion to the relative value of their respective estates to be ascertained upon the principal applicable to life annuity.
