Bond.

I know all men by these presents that we George Schurr, Sr., and James Pilgore are held and firmly bound unto the State of Ohio, in the sum of \$200<sup>00</sup> to the payment of which we hereby bind ourselves.

Signed him at London, this 30th day of September A. D. 1905.

The condition of the above obligation is such, that whereas the said George Schurr appeals to the probate court of said County from the report of the assessors Lester Bidwell, Frank Lombard, and Walter Guy in so far as it respects the assessment of compensation and damages to the said George Schurr by reason of the construction of a certain pike to be built on the petition of Emma Welsh and others beginning on the Midway Pike on the line of M. J. Sifrit and Grace Thompson and terminating on the Lyons Pike at the north East corner of Viola Birns land.

Now if the said George Schurr shall pay the costs and expenses that may arise from such appeal if said road be established and the assessment of compensation and damages be not increased and no compensation and damages be allowed said Geo. Schurr Sr. by the proceedings had in the Probate Court. Now if the said George Schurr shall pay all costs that may be adjudged against him in the Probate Court or in any other Court to which the proceedings may be removed by petition in error then this obligation shall be void, otherwise it shall be in full force and effect.
