Know all Men by These Presents that we George Shurr, Sr. and James Kilgore are held and firmly bound unto the State of Ohio, in the sum of \$200<sup>00</sup> to the payment of which we hereby bind ourselves.

Signed at London, this 30th day of September A. D. 1905.

The condition of the above obligation is such, that whereas the said George Shurr appeals to the probate court of said County from the report of the viewers Lester Bidwell, Frank Lombard, and Walter Gaylin so far as it respects the assessment of compensation and damages to the said George Shurr by reason of the construction of a certain pike to be built on the petition of Emma Welsh and others beginning on the Midway Pike on the line of M. J. Sifrit and Bruce Thompson and terminating on the Linton Pike at the North East corner of Viola Biers land.

Now if the said George Shurr shall pay the costs and expenses that may arise from such appeal if said road be established and the assessment of compensation and damages be not increased and no compensation and damages be allowed said Geo. Shurr Sr. by the proceedings had in the Probate Court. Now if the said George Shurr shall pay all costs that may be adjudged against him in the Probate Court or in any other Court to which the proceedings may be removed by petition in error then this obligation shall be void, otherwise it shall be in full force and effect.
