This day the Board of Commissioners of Madison County met in Regular session pursuant to adjournment of yesterday. Members present A. C. Millikin M. L. Rea and James Withrow

A petition signed by O. R. King and seventy eight others land holders whose lands will be assessed for the expense of the improvement mentioned below was this day presented to the Board of Commissioners of Madison County Ohio, praying for the improvement under the two-mill assessment Pike Laws of Ohio, of a road by widening draining, grading, graveling and bridging the same along the following described route.

Commencing at the Middle Pike where said King Road intersects the same, thence in a southwesterly direction through the lands of Lester Bidwell Michael Grady Edward Brathwaite, Willis Glover, J. W. King, O. R. King David Gatton Mrs. John Gilbert George Boswell and Isaac Brathwaite, in the line on the same road of the said King road to the intersection of said King Road with the Blair Pike, said road being about two and one fourth ($2\frac{1}{4}$) miles long and all in the county and state above mentioned.

A good and sufficient Bond signed by O. R. King David Gatton and Lester Bidwell in the sum of Two hundred (200) dollars, conditioned according to law, has also been filed with said Board. Thereupon said Board appointed Robert Fullerton Joseph Williams and David Brown three disinterested Free holders of the County as viewers and H. L. McCafferty as surveyor or engineer and directed them to meet at the school house known as the Lester Bidwell School House in Jefferson Township on Monday the 13th day of February 1893 at 10 o'clock A. M. and after being duly sworn, to take to their assistance two suitable persons as chain carriers, and one marker and proceed to view, examine lay out or straighten, said road as in their opinion public utility and convenience requires to assess and determine the damages sustained by any person through whose premises the road is proposed to be laid out, straightened or improved, and to do such other things in the premises as are required of them by law.

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and to make a report of their proceedings in writing to this Board at its regular session on Monday the 6th day of March 1893

The Auditor is directed to give notice as required by law in such case.

Upon each of the orders findings and apportionments in the foregoing matter the roll being called each of the Commissioners Millikin Rea. and Withrow agreed thereto Approval unanimous

Thereupon the Board adjourned to meet in regular session on Monday January 9th 1893
