

Vanner Joint Road

The Board therefore order the reports & plat in said matter to be duly recorded & filed & said improvement to be made in the following manner to wit:

Road Opened
Road Cleared

1st. That the road be opened to a width of 25 feet on each side center line
2nd. " " " " cleared of all obstructions to a width of 25 feet on each side its center line by grubbing all trees & stumps from cuts & side ditches & by cutting them off even with the ground in fills.

Road Bed

3rd. That the road bed must be smoothly & evenly graded to a width of 11 feet on each side of & crossing benches to its center line with side slopes of $1\frac{1}{2}$ feet horizontal to 1 foot vertical, leaving a 2 ft. berm of unbroken at base of all fills with center dirt grade & horizontal lines; never making a greater line than one in twenty

Side Ditches

4th. That all side ditches be made not less than 2 feet wide in bottom & that the bottom be not less than $2\frac{1}{2}$ feet below the center dirt grade line of the road, with side slopes of one to one, unobstructed & continuous leaving no ponds or pools in side ditches with complete drainage to all culverts.

Culverts

5th. That all culverts be made, side walls of stone & coverings of stone when made 6 ft. clear span & over that covering to be made of wood.

Gravel

6th. That upon the road bed, as above prepared, there be spread uniformly a layer of clean gravel, free from dirt, loam, or fine sand, 12 ft. wide & 14 inches deep in center & 8 inches deep at sides, with center line of gravel upon center line of grade, raking all coarse gravel into the bottom of the gravel layer, leaving no stones that can not pass through a $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch ring nearer than 6 inches of the top of gravel grade. In all 2160 cubic yards per mile.

The Board appointed Eliot Morse, Engineer, to take charge of said improvement, to advertise and sell the same according to law & require said work to be done by the day of 1888. Payment for said work shall be made in cash but no payment will be made until after the sale of the bonds for said improvement & for the purpose of raising money necessary to pay for said improvement it is ordered, that bonds of the County be issued of equal amounts due at intervals of six months, for the period of five years, said bonds bearing interest at the rate of six per cent. per annum, payable semi-annually & the proper assessment placed upon the road duplicate as provided in Sections 4846 Revised Statutes of Ohio.

The Board find that the following land will be benefitted by said improvement & should be assessed to pay the same for it:

Improvements heretofore made.

The Engineers and Committee of apportionment are further instructed to see that there is no omission of lots and lands within the territory sought to be assessed.

Said Committee are directed to make a report of their proceedings in writing, to said Board at their earliest convenience.

On motion of T. M. Braman, Fulton Armstrong, James S. Pancake & Saul McNeil heretofore appointed by the Comrs. of Union and Madison Counties to apportion the expense of said Improvement upon the Real property reported by the viewers as benefited, having filed their report in the Auditors Office of each of said Counties & this being the day fixed for the hearing of said report & exceptions to the same & the Joint Board of Commissioners of said Counties having met to consider the matter & proof being made satisfactory to the Joint Board that lawful notice had been given of the time and place set for said hearing, thereupon the cause came to be heard & all persons interested were granted a hearing before the Joint Board including W. A. Applegate, D. S. Burcham, Walter F. Guy, Jas. Mumma for S. C. Davis, C. S. Newman, L. F. Newman, Chas. Phellis & W. E. Yeagell, who had filed exceptions in writing to the amount of their assessments.

After careful examination of said report & hearing all exceptions thereto the Joint Board ordered that the following changes (Reductions & additions) be made in and to the assessments reported by said Committee (and no other):

Add to J. M. Bookwalter's assessment on 350 acres \$15.80 making J. M. Bookwalter's assessment on said 350 " \$169.⁸⁰.

Deduct from W. A. & Amelia Applegate's assessment \$15.⁸⁰ making W. A. & Amelia Applegate's \$38.²⁰ (said deduction is ordered on acct of error of number of acres of land assessed by apportioning Committee the said Committee assessed 242 acres the assessment should have been made on 162 acres) and that said report as changed be confirmed & that the said Auditors of said Counties place the amt's apportioned to each of their respective Counties on a Special Duplicate for collections as required by law. On questions of phraseage of all the foregoing order, all the Joint Board of Commissioners (John K. Dodge & T. M. Braman, S. H. Henderson, Saul Fralich, W. E. Beale & A. C. Willett) voted Aye.
