

Woods & West Ave. Road Improvmt.
May 8th 1889.

This day the Board of Commissioners of Madison County, Ohio, met in Special Session. Members present: W. E. Beale & L. Willett and J. O. Bower.

In the matter of the County Road Improvement
Petitioned for by Jonah Woods & others } Bond filed
known as the Woods & West Avenue } Viewers Appointed &c.
Road Improvement.

A petition signed by Jonah Woods & four other land holders whose lands will be accessed for the expense of the improvement mentioned below was this day presented to the Board of Commissioners of Madison County Ohio, praying for the improvement under the five mile accessment pike laws of Ohio, of a road by ditching, grading, graveling, culverting & bridging the same of a county road situated in Monroe, Leander & Sady townships along the following described route.

Beginning

At the Wilson & Mudgett Pike near the bridge crossing Little Sady known as the Wilson bridge in Monroe township at the intersection of the Finley & Baker County road, thence northeasterly following said road by Jno. Hollands, Jonah Woods & others to the old Columbus road near the Lombard School House, thence crossing said Columbus road at the intersections of the West Avenue County Road & following said West Avenue road northeasterly by the lands of Jno. Florence, Jay & no. Ira Syer, John H. Finley, Neagridge & others to the Morgridge & Weaver pike in Sady Township.

The petitioners ask that said road be constructed with a double track, one of earth & one of gravel. A good & sufficient bond signed by Jonah Woods, W. A. Finley & Charles Bradley in the sum of \$200. & conditioned according to law, has also been filed with said Board. Thereupon said Board appointed James Wilkins, Henry Wright & James M. Willard three disinterested free holders of the County as viewers & J. J. Converse as Surveyor or engineer & directed them to meet at the store of W. A. Finley in Reaca, Madison County, Ohio on Thursday May 30th 1889 at 10 o'clock A.M. & after being duly sworn to take to their assistance two suitable persons as chain carriers & one marker & proceed to view, examine, lay out, or straighten said road as in their opinion public utility & convenience requires; to assess & determine the damages sustained by any person through whose premises the road is proposed to be laid out straightened or improved & to do such other things in the premises as are required of them by law & to make a report of their proceedings in writing to this Board at its next regular session on Monday the 3rd day of June 1889 at 11 o'clock A.M.

The Auditor is directed to give notice as required by law in such case.

Woods & West Ave. Road Improv't. June 5. 1889

In the Matter of the Woods Road Improv't

The report of the viewers heretofore appointed having been made as required by law, & said report being in favor of said improvement & showing that there is a public necessity therefor & the Board being satisfied by a comparison & count of the petitioners for said improvement & land holders taxable therefor, as reported by the viewers & other evidence that a majority of land owners whose lands will be assessed for the expense of the same, have signed the same, petitions asking for said improvement (said majority being 48) that public utility requires it & that the proceedings heretofore had are in conformity to law. The Board thereupon order the reports & plat in said matter to be duly recorded & filed & said improvement to be made in the following manner to wit:

Specifications.

1. That the road bed be opened to a width of . ft. on each side its center line.
2. The road bed & all bridges & culverts to be made 24 ft. wide. The culverts are to be of first class sewer pipe with stone heading the bridges to be stone abutments with wing walls & wooden superstructures.
3. The gravel to be placed upon one side of the grade as above prepared. 11 ft. wide, 12 inches in the center, & 10 inches at the edges with all coarse gravel raked in to the bottoms of the gravel layer.

The Board thereupon appoint Dr. J. Lawrence as Engineer to take charge of said improvement, to advertise and sell the same, according to law, & require said work to be done by the day of payment of said work will be made in cash, but no payment will be made until after the sale of the bonds, for said improvement & for the purpose of raising money necessary to pay for said improvement, It is ordered that bonds of the County be issued of equal amounts due at intervals of six months for the period of 8 years. Said bonds bearing interest at the rate of six per cent per annum payable semi-annually, & the proper assessments placed upon the road duplicate as provided in sections 484 & 6. Rev. Statutes of Ohio. The Board find that the following lands will be benefited by said improvement & should be assessed to pay for same to wit:
