Morain in the line of Edward Fitzgerald thence with his lines passing S. W. corner to Henry Fleckers survey No 5190 at 19 poles S 38 E 186 poles to the S. W. corner of said survey; thence with another line of said survey and Charles Woodson's survey N 54 E 240 poles to the S. E. corner to Woodson in the line of Beck's survey No 8870; thence with said line N 32 1/2 W 65 poles to a stake corner of Edward Fitzgerald; thence with his line and the line survey No 5766 N 44 E 262 poles to the County line between Pickaway and Madison; thence with said line N 1/2 E 65 poles to a stone corner of Franklin, Pickaway & Madison Counties; (thence with the line between Franklin & Madison N 6 W 1990 poles, crossing road at 24 poles, at 193 poles, at 368 poles, and the Lockburn road at 1064 poles, the Georgiaville road at 1655 poles, to a stone at the S. E. corner of Jefferson Township, a white oak beam N 84 1/2 E 1 pole; thence with the line of Jefferson Township S 84 1/2 W 1450 poles, crossing the road near Thomas Cullumber's at 141 poles, the California and Jefferson road at 639 poles, & the road near Carlton Grepps at 962 poles, to a stone S. W. corner to

Beck's survey No 12141 & 11096, southerly corner to George Dawson survey No 9718, being also a corner to Henry Adams Preston Adams and Carlton E. Gregg, and corner to Jefferson Township; thence with the lines of said Township, Deer Creek & Union Townships; thence with Union Township line & line of 6783 S 6 E 215 poles, crossing the Georgiaville road to beginning.

The lines joining Pleasant Township were surveyed by Wm. L. Allen in 1853.

The lines joining Oak Run Township were surveyed by D. B. Warner in 1856.

The lines joining Jefferson and Union Townships were surveyed by Brinkman and Monry in 1860.

The County line was surveyed by A. S. Monry in 1860.
