



# Jefferson Township

Beginning at a stone in the county line between Madison & Franklin Counties at the N. E. corner to Fairfield township. Thence with said township line S 84 1/2 W 1450 poles. passing a stone on east side of bullumber road at 140 P. — a point 10 poles south of old Duflinger house at 251 P. — a stone on east side of Jefferson & California road 657 P. — & a stone on east side of Jefferson & Lower Glade road at 960 P. — to a stone at the N.W. corner of John Beck survey No. 12141 & 11096 & a corner to Union, Fairfield & Deer Creek Townships. Thence with Deer Creek Township line N 4 1/2 W 509 P. crossing Columbus & Genia Rail Road at 464 P. — to a stone at the North edge of Jefferson, South Charleston & Genia Turnpike. Thence N 18 W 480 P. passing 4th mile stone from Jefferson on the National Road at 407 P. to a stone in east line of survey No. 6652. Thence N 87 1/2 W 425 P. passing stone at east side of a road at 202 to a stone on east bank of Glade run. Thence N 6 W 726 poles passing a stone at North side of a road at 297 P. and a stone at North side of Mechanicsburg Turnpike at 589 — running the last 30 poles in Little Darby creek to the lower corner of Robert Vance survey No. 1095 3 poles east of a stone placed on west bank



of said creek - corner to Monroe Township  
 Thence with lines of Monroe Township being  
 lines of B. Vance Survey No 1095 N 54 1/2 E  
 390 p. to a stone & 2 Hickories Thence N 9 3/4 W  
 475 p. passing upper corner of said survey No 1095  
 at 397 p. to a stone corner to Monroe & Canaan  
 Townships - Thence with line of Canaan Township  
 1888 & 1688 p. passing stone on east side of  
 Sandusky road at 735 poles - a stone on east  
 side of Road 1026 p. - & a stone on east side  
 of Jefferson & Amity road at 1628 p. to an elm  
 on bank of Big Darby Creek. Thence down  
 the creek with the meanders thereof to a stone  
 corner to Franklin County Thence with  
 Franklin County line N 78 W 395 poles passing  
 Georgiaville Road to a stone. Thence S 68 1/2 W  
 crossing Little Darby Creek at 11 p to the beginning
