



Surveyed for Cadwallader Wallace, assee, 100 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 5876 on Opposom Run a branch of Deer Creek. Beginning at two Hickories and a Bur Oak, Northeasterly corner to John Hurt's Survey No. 6057 and corner to Joseph Hite's Survey No. 9269; thence with a line of Hite's said Survey, North 157 poles to two Hickories and a White Oak, corner to said Survey; thence with another line of said Survey, West 150 poles, crossing the run at 68 poles and a branch at 128 poles to a Stake, 3 poles North of five White Oaks marked as a corner; thence South 56 poles, passing said five White Oaks and passing three Bur Oaks to two Jack Oaks, corner to Hite's said Survey; thence with another line of Hite's said Survey, S. 56 E. 182 poles, crossing the run at 65 poles to the beginning.

Surveyed for Valentine Wilson, assee. 276 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 111 on Oak run a branch of Deer Creek. Beginning at a Stake in the line of the Representatives of Peter Helphinstine's Survey No. 4515, Northwesterly corner to Peter Muhlenberg's Survey, No. 5429 & 8744; thence with the line of Muhlenberg's Survey N. 46 E. 238 poles to a Stake, North corner to said Survey; thence N. 44 W. 60 poles to a Stake; thence N. 46 E. 73 poles, crossing the run to a Stake; thence N. 39 W. 60 poles to a Stake in the line of Joseph Harness's Survey No. 5531 of 280 acres; thence with the line of said Survey, S. 39 W. 303 poles, crossing the run to a Stake, corner to said Survey; thence N. 40 W. 127 poles, crossing the run at 20 poles to a White Oak and Hickory, Northwesterly corner to said Survey; thence N. 39 E. 304 poles to a Stake at the intersection of the line of Harness's said Survey with the line of Richard Apperson's Survey No. 6288; thence with the line of Apperson's said Survey, N. 40 W. 370 poles to two White Oaks and a Hickory, corner to said Survey and corner to Daniel Bedinger's Survey No. 7079; thence S. 37 E. 184 poles to two Hickories and a Bur Oak, East corner to Bedinger's said Survey; thence S. 9½ W. 381 poles to a White Oak and Hickory, corner to said Survey and corner to Helphinstine's said Survey; thence with the line of Helphinstine's said Survey, S. 40 E. 206 poles, crossing the run at 107 poles, to the beginning.
