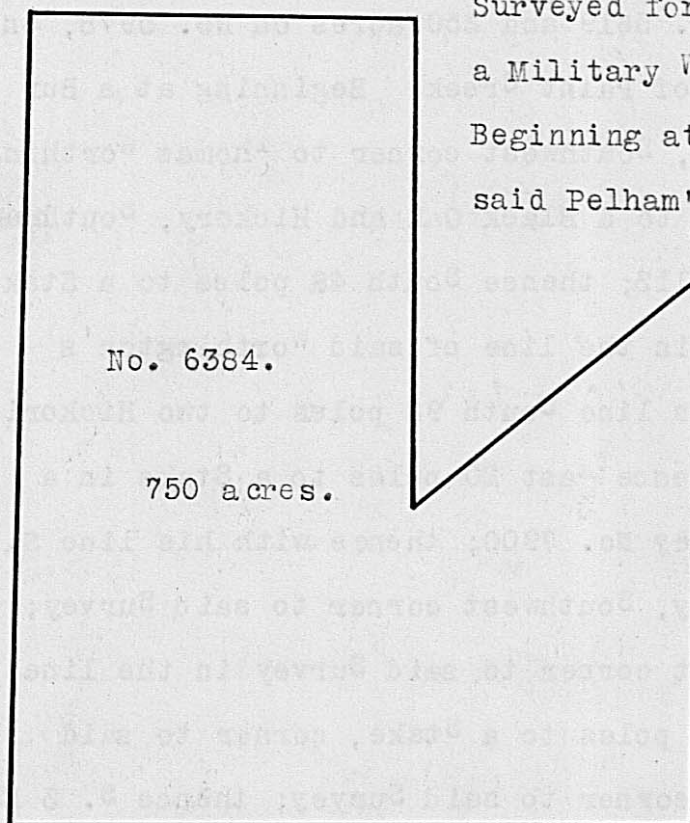


Surveyed for Peter Pelham, assee. 750 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 5497, on the waters of Deer creek. Beginning at three Bur Oaks, Southwest corner to the Representatives of Peter Helphinstine's Survey No. 4515; thence with said line North 90 poles to a Bur Oak and Hickory, corner to George Hoffman's Survey No. 6241, in Helphenstine's line; thence with Hoffman's line S. 50 W. 207 poles to two Elms, a Black Walnut in said line; thence South 299 poles to a Hickory and Post Oak; thence East 308 poles to three Hickories; thence South 100 poles to a Stake, a Bur Oak and Hickory; thence East 300 poles to a Stake corner to Peter Muhlenberg's in the line of Helphenstine's Survey No. 4513; thence N. 16 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 40 poles to five Hickories, corner to Helphenstine's said Survey; thence North 40 poles to two Black Oaks and a Hickory, passing the Northwest corner of Helphinstine's Survey at 30 poles; thence West 235 poles to a Bur Oak and Hickory; thence North 150 poles to a Stake in a prairie, Southwest corner to John Shearer's Survey No. 5529; thence with said line N. 4 W. 160 poles to a Stake in the line of Helphenstine's Survey No. 4515; thence with said line S. 86 W. 130 poles to three White Oaks; thence N. 40 W. 84 poles to the beginning.

Beginning at two Elms and a Black Walnut, Northwest corner to said Pelham's Survey of 750 acres No. 6384, in the line of George Hoffman's Survey No. 6241; thence with Hoffman's line S. 50 W. 193 poles to a Stake in a prairie; thence North 252 poles to a Jack Oak and White Oak; thence West 204 poles to a White Oak and Hickory; thence South 424 poles to two Hickories, a Black Oak; thence East 357 poles to a Hickory and Post Oak, Southwest corner to said Pelham's other Survey No. 6384; thence with his line North 299 poles to the beginning.
