assee. 3200 acres of land on three Military Warrants, No. 5630, 5632, 5635 and on part of two No. 5636 and 5637, on the waters of Deer Creek.

Beginning at a Burr Oak, N. 65 E. 85 poles from the North-erly corner of David Bradford's Survey No. 3972, running

N. 25 W. 124 poles to a Bur Oak; thence N. 60 W. 284 poles to two

hickories; thence N. 40 W. 130 poles crossing a branch to a Black Oak;

thence S. 88 W. 180 poles to a large Elm on the North side of a prairie; thence S. 45 W.

101 poles to a White Oak and Hickory in the Northeast line of Elias Langham's Survey No.

4777; thence with his line N. 45 W. 185 poles, crossing Bradford's fork at 48, at 84 and

a branch at 160 poles to a White Oak and Hickory, North corner to said Langham's Survey;

thence S. 76 W. 270 poles, crossing Bradford's fork at 250 poles to two White Oaks and a

Black Oak; thence S. 85 W. 30 poles to two Burr Oaks; thence N. 45 W. 304 poles, crossing

the fork at 274 poles to three Hickories; thence N. 45 E. 420 poles, crossing a branch at

48 poles, one at 68 and one at 130 and one at 200 poles to three Burr oaks from one root

and two Hickories; thence N. 61 E. 270 poles to three White Oaks; thence East 430 poles
