


Surveyed for James Johnston, 880 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 5792 on the Gladly Run a branch of the Spring fork of Treacle's creek. Beginning at three White Oaks, South-westerly corner to James Galloway's Survey No. 6030; thence with his line N. 10 W. 60 poles to two Bur Oaks, Northwesterly corner to said Survey; thence with another of his lines S. 82 E. 134 poles crossing the run at 38 poles to a Black Oak corner to said Galloway's Survey; thence N. 62 W. 222 poles to a White Oak and Hickory; thence N. 36 W. 66 poles to two Hickories; thence N. 49 W. 56 poles to a large Bur Oak on the edge of a prairie; thence S. 44 W. 116 poles, crossing a branch at 8 poles to a Bur Oak; thence S. 57 W. 172 poles to two Bur Oaks and a White Oak; thence N. 75 W. 62 poles to a Stake; thence S. 15 W. 94 poles to a Stake in the line of said Galloway's Survey No. 7404; thence with said line S. 75 E. 43 poles to a Bur Oak corner to said Survey; thence with another of his lines N. 15 E. 14 poles to three White Oaks another of his corners; thence S. 75 E. 90 poles to a Stake in a prairie, corner to Galloway; thence with another of his lines S. 15 W. 204 poles crossing two branches in a prairie to a stake in a prairie, Southeasterly corner to Galloway's said Survey; thence N. 74 W. 108 poles to a Bur Oak and Hickory in Galloway's line; thence South 102 poles to two Bur Oaks in the edge of a prairie; thence S. 74 E. 183 poles crossing a branch at 106 poles to a large Bur Oak and two Hickories; thence N. 47 E. 127 poles to two Bur Oaks; thence N. 27 E. 156 poles to a Bur Oak on the edge of a prairie; thence N. 54 E. 73 poles to a large Bur Oak on the edge of a prairie; thence N. 47 E. 119 poles to the beginning.

Beginning at two White Oaks and a Hickory, South corner to David Bradford's Survey No. 4208; thence N. 65 E. 177 poles to a Stake in the West line of George Baylor's Survey No. 464; thence with said line N. 20 W. 94 poles to four White Oaks, Westerly corner to said Survey and Southerly corner to Thomas Bell's Survey No. 462; thence N. 45 W. 100 poles to two Black Oaks, Easterly corner to Bradford's said Survey; thence S. 14 W. 240 poles to the beginning.
