

Beginning at three Bur Oaks on the edge of a prairie, S. 9 W. 96 poles from the Southerly corner of John Graham's Survey No. 7928; thence S. 65 W. 128 poles to two Hickories; thence S. 27 E. 138 poles to a Hickory in a prairie; thence S. 85 E. 151 poles to a Stake in a prairie; thence N. 5 W. 52 poles to four Bur Oaks; thence N. 7 W.

49 poles to four Bur Oaks from one root on the edge of a prairie; thence N. 15 W. 98 poles to four Hickories, three of them from one root; thence S. 87° 30' W. 57 poles to the Enoch Hanaman, Walter Dun, D.S. Henry Frack, C.C. April 29th, 1815. Robert Frack, M. May 19th, 1815.



Surveyed for John Graham and Walter Dun, asees. 200 acres of land on part of six Military Warrants, Graham 30 acres on No. 5791, 29 acres on No. 5786, 35 acres on No. 5881, 44 acres on No. 5787, 39 acres on No. 5784 and Dun 23 acres on No. 5735, on the waters of Deer creek. Beginning at a Bur Oak in a prairie, 62 poles N. 779 30' W. from the westerly corner of Graham and Scrugg's Survey No.

8087; thence S. 17 W. 160 poles to a Stake in a prairie; thence N. 73 W. 200 poles to a Stake in a prairie; thence N. 17 E. 160 poles crossing a branch at 37 poles to a Bur Oak on the edge of a prairie; thence S. 73 E. 200 poles to the beginning.

Surveyed for Robertson Burge, assee. 200 acres of land on a Military "arrant No. 5707, on the waters of Darby's creek. Beginning at two Hickories and a forked Jack Oak, Easterly No. 8083. 200 acres. corner to John Graham's Survey No. 7928; thence with his line N. 77 W. 110 poles to three Bur Oaks from one root, Northerly corner to the said Survey; thence with another of his lines S. 21 W. 140 poles to two Bur Oaks, Westerly corner to said Survey and Southeasterly corner to Gross Scrugg's Survey No. 7813; thence with Scrugg's line N. 12 E. 120 poles to two Bur Oak, Easterly corner to Scrugg's; thence with another of his lines, S. 80° 30' W. 35 poles to two Elms and a Jack Oak in said line, Southerly corner to said Graham's Survey No. 7927; thence with said line, N. 25 E. 194 poles to two Bur Oaks and a Hickory, Easterly corner to said Survey; thence S. 76 E. 179 poles to a Bur Oak and two Hickories in the line of the Representatives of Anthony T. Dixon's Survey No. 7055; thence with said line S. 21° 30' E. 100 poles crossing a branch at 14 poles to a Bur Oak and Elm in said line.
