


Surveyed for Jacob Woolston, assignee, 1000 acres of land on six Military Warrants Nos. 2217, 3588, 3534, 3486, 3503 and 3520 on Treacles Creek. Beginning at four honey locusts on the upper side of the creek, running N. 53 E. 480 poles to a red oak and elm; thence S. 37 E. 320 poles to a hickory, elm and white oak; thence S. 53 W. 500

poles crossing the creek at 400 poles to three white oaks; thence N. 37 W. 320 poles to two hickories and an elm; thence N. 53 E. 20 poles crossing the Creek to the beginning.

William Crawford, Daniel Thompson, C.C. Samuel Robertson, M. Lucas Sullivant, D.S. June 24th, 1797. April 2nd, 1798



Surveyed for Samuel Wallace, heir at law to Andrew Wallace, dec'd. 750 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 3196, on the upper side of Treacles Creek. Beginning at an elm, walnut and two mulberries, upper corner to Robert Vance's Survey No. 1095, running up the creek with the meanders thereof, N. 20 W. 24, N. 53 W. 24, North 18, N. 40 E. 46, N. 30 W. 160, North 32, N. 53 E. 10, N. 18 W.

44, N. 25 E. 20, North 18 poles to three white oaks and a red elm; thence N. 53 E. 294 poles to two ashes and a large forked burr oak, formerly cornered; thence S. 37 E. 320 poles to two white oaks and a hickory; northeast corner to said Vance's Survey; thence with his line S. 53 W. 430 poles to the beginning.

Surveyed for Lucas Sullivant, assignee 100 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 4849 on Darby's Creek. Beginning on the bank of the Creek at a hickory, white oak and burr oak on the lower side of the creek, running up the creek with the meanders thereof N. 22 E. 80, N. 12 W. 24, North 24 poles to an elm; thence N. 78 W. 122 poles to a

large white oak in the edge of a prairie; thence S. 12 W. 125 poles to a stake; thence S. 78 E. 122 poles to the beginning.
