


Surveyed for Thomas Worthington, assee. 1016 acres of land on Six Military Warrants No. 6083, 6084, 6087, 222 acres each, No. 6106 for 200 acres, 50 acres on part of No. 5980 and 100 acres on No. 6141, on the waters of Deer Creek. Beginning at four White Oaks, East corner to said Worthington's Survey No. 6197; Northeast corner to his Survey No. 5466, 6824, 7112 & 7612 and South corner to David Bradford's Survey No. 3972; thence with his line N. 65 E. 187 poles to three White Oaks, Easterly corner to said Survey, South corner to said Bradford's Survey No. 3971, and Westerly corner to William Palmer's Survey No. 8037; thence with his line S. 25 E. 662 poles passing his South corner and with the line of Joseph Evans' Survey No. 9760, passing his South corner and with the line of Smith Snead's Survey No. 3405, to two Bur Oaks, a Southwesterly corner to said Survey in the line of the Representatives of Benjamin Harrison's Survey No. 9018; thence with said line West 147 poles to two Bur Oaks, corner to said Survey; thence South 80 poles to a Stake in a prairie; thence West 300 poles to three Bur Oaks; thence North 161 poles to two Post Oaks; thence East 37 poles to a Hickory; thence N. 4 E. 110 poles to two Hickories and a Post Oak; thence West 40 poles to two Post Oaks; thence North 32 poles to a Hickory and White Oak, Northeast corner to Walter Dun's Survey No. 9249; thence N. 87 E. 6 poles to a Black Oak, Elm and Red Oak and White Oak, Southeast corner to Worthington's Survey No. 5456 &c; thence North 70 poles to two Post Oaks and a Hickory, Southwest corner to Margaret Neil's Survey No. 7219; thence with her lines East 126 poles to a Hickory and Post Oak, Southeast corner to said Survey; thence North 131 poles to a Stake in a prairie, Northeast corner to said Survey; thence West 125 poles to a small Post Oak, Northwest corner to said Survey in the line of Worthington's last mentioned Survey; thence North 100 poles to the beginning.

Surveyed for John A. Fulton, assee. 200 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 6101, on the head waters of Paint Creek, and the Little Miami. Beginning at three Bur Oaks, East 44 poles from the Southwest corner of Peter Pelham's Survey No. 6384; thence East 188 poles to two Bur Oaks, Northwest corner to John D. Terrell and other's Survey No. 8221 (withdrawn); thence South 172 poles to a Stake; thence West 188 poles to a Stake; thence North 172 poles to the beginning.
