



Beginning at a Bur Oak, Northerly corner to James Johnson's Survey No. 7240; thence with a line of said Survey S. 27 W. 140 poles crossing a branch at 100 poles to a Stake in a prairie in said line, from which a Bur Oak marked as a corner bears N. 6 W. 6 poles; thence N. 60 W. 116 poles, crossing a branch at 40 poles to two Bur Oaks and an Elm; thence N. 21½ E. 181 poles to an Elm and Bur Oak; thence N. 88 E. 82 poles to a Bur Oak and Jack Oak; thence S. 84 E. 42 poles to 7 Bur Oaks, Northerly corner to the Heirs of Nathaniel Fox, deceased Survey No. 8481; thence with a line of said Survey S. 28 W. 74 poles to 7 White Oaks, another corner to said Survey; thence S. 10 E. 36 poles to the beginning.

Beginning at a Stake in a prairie, Southwest corner to Walter Dun's Survey No. 11012; thence South 83 poles to two Bur Oaks; thence West 80 poles to a Stake in a prairie 3-3/4 poles S. 54 W. from a Bur Oak marked as a corner; thence North 124 poles to a Stake in a prairie, near a Bur Oak; thence N. 43 W. 57 poles to a Stake in a prairie, near two Bur Oaks from one root; thence N. 10 E. 100 poles to two Bur Oaks from one root, corner to Dun and Graham's Survey No. 8586 & 8688; thence with their line S. 65 E. 80 poles to a Bur Oak in a prairie, corner to their said Survey; thence S. 79 E. 38 poles to a Stake in a prairie, their Southeasterly corner; thence with another of their lines N. 11 E. 22 poles to a Bur Oak in said line; thence S. 75 E. 31 poles to a Stake in a prairie, in the line of said Dun's Survey No. 11012; thence with said line S. 14 W. 158 poles to the beginning.
