Surveyed for Garret Cronk, Jeremiah Devor and John Pope, assees. 300 acres of land on three Military Warrants, to-wit: Cronk 100 acres on No. 6296, Devor 100 acres on No. 6297 and Pope 100 acres on part of No. 6306, on the waters of Treacle's Creek. Beginning at a Hickory, Southwesterly corner of James Galloway's Survey No. 12019 & 11020; thence with his line North 174 poles, crossing several drains to a Bur Oak in said line, an Easterly corner of said Galloway's Survey No. 7403; thence with the line of said Survey No. 7403, correcting its course S. 19 W. 225 poles to a Stake at the Northeast corner of the Heirs Nicholas Hobson's Survey No. 6350 and Northwest corner to Silvanus Bourne's Survey No. 10926; thence with Bourne's line S. 80 E. 111½ poles to a Hickory and Post Oak at his Northeast corner; thence with another of his lines S. 18 W. 176 poles crossing a drain to four Hickories at his Southeast corner and corner to the Heirs of Hobson's said Survey No. 6350; thence with their line S. 10 W. 137 poles crossing a drain and branch to two Bur Oaks, another of their corners; thence S. 80 E. 28 poles, crossing a branch to a Black Oak and White Oak, another of their corners and the most Westerly corner of Galloway & Foreman's Survey No. 10953; thence with Galloway's & Foreman's line and the line of said Galloway's Survey No. 7404, and passing the North corner of No. 7404 at 236 poles, N. 37 E. 338 poles in all, crossing a drain to a stake in the line of said Survey No. 12019 & 11020; thence with said line N. 50 W. 156 poles, crossing several drains to two Bur Oaks, corner to said Survey; thence with another line thereof, West 74½ poles to the beginning.
