

Northwesterly corner to George Mathew's Survey No. 5749; thence with his line South 120 poles, crossing Three Mile run at 56 poles to four White Oaks two of them from one root in the edge of a prairie; thence S. 57 E. 78 poles to three small Bur Oaks, two of them from one root; thence S. 73 E. 54 poles No. 8696. crossing a small branch at 20 poles to two Bur Oaks; thence N. 79 E. 50 poles to three Elms from one root; thence N. 3 E. 62 poles to two Red Vims: thence N. 19 W. 26 poles to a Bur Oak in the back line of John 240 acres. Crawford's Survey No. 2681; thence with said line N. 37 W. 52 poles to two Bur Oaks on the bank of Three Mile run; thence N. 16 W. 230 poles crossing the run at 2 poles and a branch at 170 poles to two Bur Oaks; thence N. 48 W. 40 poles to two Bur Oaks and an Elm.
