

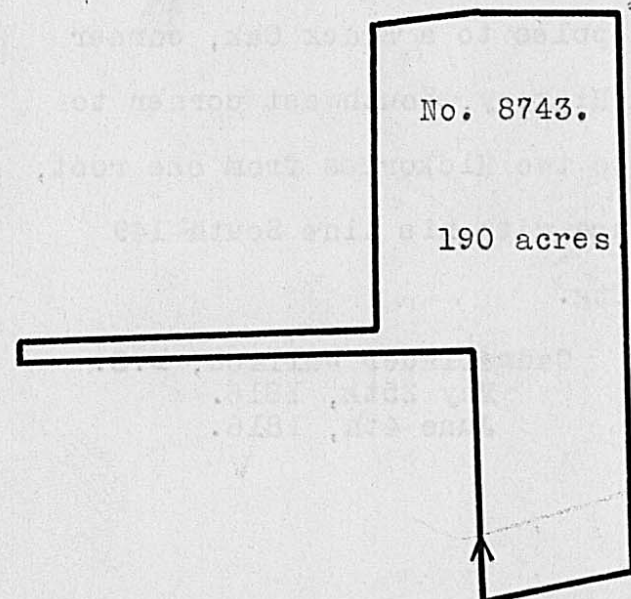

Beginning at two Elms a White Oak and Hickory, Southeasterly corner to said Hoffman's Survey No. 6247; thence N. 81° 20' E. 78 poles to two Hickories and a White Oak; thence North 290 poles to a Stake in a prairie; thence West 85 poles to two Hickories, East corner to the Representatives of Peter Helphenstine's Survey No. 4515; thence S. 86 W. 46 poles to a Stake, Northeast corner to said Hoffman's Survey No. 6248; thence South 164 poles to two Black Oaks, Southeast corner to said Survey; thence West 186 poles to a Stake,
