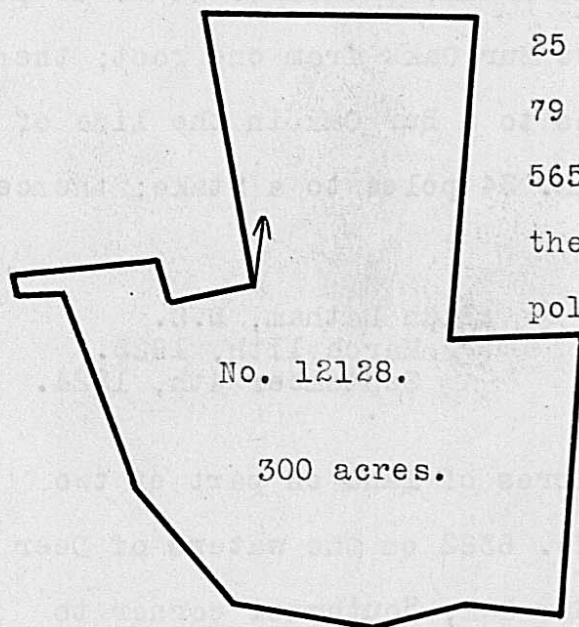

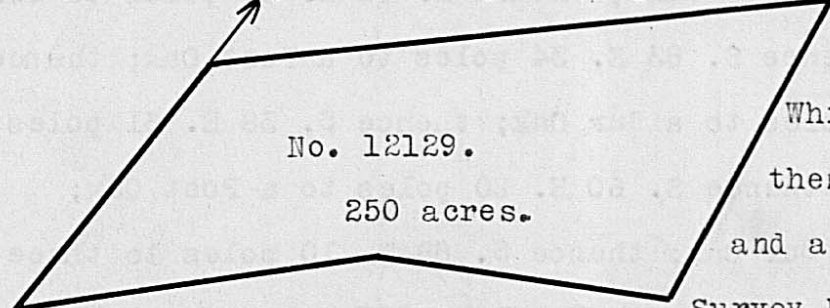
25 poles to a Red Oak, White Oak and Hickory; thence S. 80 W. 79 poles to three Bur Oaks from one root, in the line of No. 5652; thence S. 10 E. $6\frac{1}{2}$ poles to a Black Oak and Hickory; thence East $28\frac{1}{2}$ poles to a Jack Oak; thence S. 20 E. $116\frac{1}{3}$ poles to four Elms; thence S. 43 E. 77 poles to a Black Oak and Hickory; thence S. 82 E. 71 poles to three Bur Oaks and a White Oak, Northerly corner to No. 7628; thence with the lines of No. 7628, N. 80 E. $50\frac{1}{2}$ poles to three Bur Oaks; thence S. 83 E. 43 poles to three Bur Oaks from one root, corner to No. 6479; thence with the

lines of said Survey N. 4 E. 142 poles to a Black Oak and two Hickories; thence West 70 poles to two Bur Oaks and a Black Oak; thence N. 4 E. 165 poles to two Bur Oaks, Northwest corner to No. 8479; thence West 160 poles to two White Oaks, corner to No. 923; thence S. 10 E. 143 poles to the beginning.

thence with his line S. 70 W. 159 poles to a White Oak, Bur Oak, Hickory and large Black Oak thence S. 66 E. 188 poles to two Hickories and a Black Oak, North corner to John Crawford's Survey No. 6201; thence with his line S. 50 E. 152

poles to a White Oak, his corner; thence N. 61 E. 178 poles to three White Oaks, South corner to Representatives of William Case's Survey No. 5481; thence N. $64\frac{1}{2}$ W. 328 poles to the beginning.
