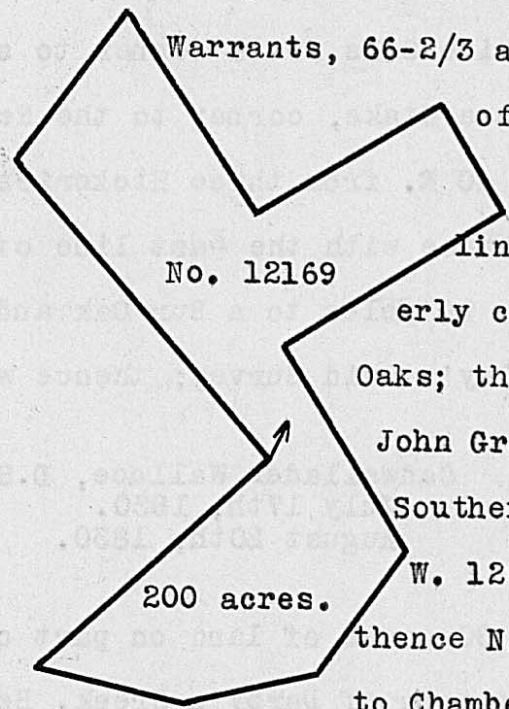


Surveyed for Mary Stephenson 300 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 6441 on the waters of Deer Creek. Beginning at two White Oaks and a Bur Oak, Southerly corner to Gross Scrugg's Survey No. 7828; thence East 131 poles to a Black Oak and Hickory; thence N. 82 E. 66 poles to a large Bur Oak and Hickory; thence N. 23 E 120 poles to a Bur Oak; thence S. 80½ E. 123 poles to a Black Oak, White Oak and Hickory; thence N. 71 E. 45 poles to four Bur Oaks from one root; thence N. 15 W. 106 poles to three Hickories and a Bur Oak, corner to Scruggs and corner to Dun and Graham's Survey No. 9199 &c; thence S. 57 E. 144 poles to two Bur Oaks corner to said Survey; thence S. 32 W. 133 poles to a double Bur Oak in a prairie; thence S. 70 E. 10 poles to two Bur Oaks and a Hickory, Northwesterly corner to John Graham's Survey No. 7560; thence S. 15 W. 138 poles to a Bur Oak and large Black Oak, Northeasterly corner to Stubblefield's No. 6317; thence N. 67 W. 68 poles to two Elms and an Ash; thence N. 23 E. 20 poles to an Elm; thence N. 52 W. 89 poles to two Black Oaks and Elm; thence S. 60 W. 183 poles to three White Oaks; thence N. 26 W. 77 poles to a forked White Oak; thence N. 76 W. 62 poles to two Hickories and a Bur Oak, Northwesterly corner to No. 6317; thence N. 37 W. 22 poles to the beginning.

Surveyed for Samuel Smith, assee. 200 acres of land on part of two Military Warrants, 66-2/3 acres on No. 6518 and 133-1/3 acres on No. 6519, on the waters of Darby's Creek. Beginning at two Bur Oaks, the Easterly corner of James Galloway's Survey No. 6602; thence with his line S. 20 W. 162 poles to two Black Oaks and a Bur Oak, Southerly corner to said Survey; thence N. 75½ E. 86 poles to two Bur Oaks; thence N. 49 E. 68 poles to three Bur Oaks, Northerly corner to John Graham's Survey No. 7393; thence N. 8½ E. 75 poles to a Stake, Southerly corner to Joseph Chamber's Survey No. 7400; thence N. 60 W. 120 poles to a Stake, Westerly corner to Chamber's said Survey; thence N. 30 E. 133 poles to a Stake in a prairie, Northerly corner to Chamber's said Survey in the line of Graham and Johnston's Survey No. 7245; thence with said line N. 60 W. 62 poles to a Hickory and two Jack Oaks in said line, Easterly corner to said Chamber's Survey No. 7399; thence S. 50 W. 109 poles to a Stake, Southerly corner to said Survey No. 7399; thence N. 60 W. 127 poles to a Stake, Westerly corner to Chamber's said last mentioned Survey; thence S. 7 W. 96 poles, passing two Dogwoods and a Black Oak, a corner to Galloway's said Survey No. 6602 and with his line to two Bur Oaks another of his corners; thence with another of his lines S. 70 E. 208 poles to the beginning.
