on Treacle's creek. Beginning at a three pronged Sycamore and Honey Locust on the Bank
of the creek, upper corner on the creek to Peyton Powell's Survey No. 2451 and lower
corner on the creek to Duncan McArthur's Survey No. 4742; thence with McArthur's line
S. 13 W. 126 poles to a Black Oak and two White Oaks from one root, his lower back
corner and Northeasterly corner to James Galloway's Survey No. 6971; thence with
Galloway's line S. 3° 30' W. 150 poles to a Stake and Bur Oak, Southeasterly corner
to said Survey and Easterly corner to said Galloway's Survey No. 6663; thence with
the last mentioned line S. 23 W. 34 poles to a Stake and two Bur Oaks in said line;
No. 9232. thence S. 77 E. 58 poles to two White Oaks; thence N. 30 E. 174 poles
90 acres. crossing a pond from 72 to 92 poles to two small White Oaks; thence N. 77

of Thomas Worthington's Survey No. 5456, 6824, 7112 & 7612; thence with
said line N. 87 E. 124 poles crossing the branch at 80 poles to a
No. 9249. Hickory and barren Oak in said line; thence South 249 poles to the
180 acres. beginning.
