



Surveyed for Cadwallader Wallace, assee. 563 $\frac{1}{2}$ acres of land on part of two Military Warrants 463 $\frac{1}{2}$ acres on No. 5825 and 100 acres on No. 6217 on the waters of the Little Miami. Beginning at three pronged bur Oaks the most westerly corner to James Galloway's Survey No. 8274; thence with his line N. 61 E. 84 poles to two Hickories and a Bur Oak, corner to said Survey; thence N. 18 W. 63 poles to three Hickories from one root, corner to said Survey; thence N. 14 E. 84 poles to three Hickories, Northwesterly corner to said Survey in the line of said Wallace's Survey No. 8819; thence with his line West 190 poles to a Stake in a prairie corner to said Survey, in the line of William Bonniface's Survey No. 8819; thence with said line S. 37 W. 203 poles to a Stake in his line; thence N. 41 W. 82 poles to a Stake in another of his lines; thence with said line N. 37 E. 194 poles to a Black Oak and two Hickories, Northwesterly corner to said Survey and Southwesterly corner to

Wallace's said Survey; thence with his line N. 16 E. 50 poles to a Stake in a prairie, Northwesterly corner to said Survey in the line of Marks Vandewall's Survey No. 8984; thence with his line N. 65 W. 10 poles to a Stake in a prairie, Southwesterly corner to Vandewall's said Survey; thence with another of his lines and the line of Mead and Baird's Survey No. 5723, N. 16 E. 280 poles to two White Oaks and two Bur Oaks, Southeasterly corner to said Wallace's Survey No. 8615; thence with his line N. 85 W. 122 poles to two Hickories and a White Oak, Southwesterly corner to said Survey and Northeasterly corner to said Vandewall's Survey No. 8983; thence with his line S. 19 E. 56 poles to three Bur Oaks, corner to said Survey; thence S. 31 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 147 poles to a Stake in a prairie, corner to said Survey; thence N. 84 W. 185 poles to a Stake in a prairie corner to said Survey and Northerly corner to said Wallace's Survey No. 8616; thence with his line S. 53 E. 125 poles to two Hickories, his westerly corner; thence S. 84 E. 123 poles to a Stake in a prairie; thence S. 37 W. 213 poles to a Bur Oak; thence S. 41 E. 286 poles passing the Westerly corner of Samuel Lapsley's Survey No. 8227 at 46 poles and with his line to a Stake in a prairie, Westerly corner to Ladd's and Norvell's Survey No. 9008; thence with their line N. 50 E. 96 poles to the beginning.
