

with said line binding thereon S. 87 W. 568 poles to a Stake in the Northerly line of Mathew Hobson's Survey No. 7265; thence with said line S. 43 E. 169 poles to a Bur Oak, corner to Hobson's said Survey; thence S. 68 E. 124 poles to two Bur Oaks, East corner to said Survey; thence S. 29 W. 74 poles crossing the fork at 32 poles to a Stake, corner to said Survey; thence N. 68 W. 204 poles to two Bur Oaks, corner to said Survey and corner to George Hoffman's Survey No. 6908 & 6909; thence S. 24 W. 228 poles to three Bur Oaks corner to Hoffman's said Survey; thence West 137 poles to three Elms, Northeast corner to David Stephenson's Survey No. 5591; thence South 160 poles to a stake, Northwest corner to said Stephenson's Survey No. 5823; thence East 123 poles to a White Oak, Northeast corner to said Survey; thence South 28 poles to a Stake in a Westerly line of the Representatives of Robert Armstrong's Survey No. 3965; thence binding thereon S. 63 E. 100 poles to two Hickories and a White Oak corner to said Survey; thence N. 70 E. 33 poles to two White Oaks, two Hickories and a Black Oak, corner to said Survey; thence N. 53 E. 61 poles to two Elms and two White Oaks corner to said Survey; thence S. 40 E. 30 poles to a double White Oak corner to said Survey; thence S. 63 E. 216 poles to three White Oaks corner to said Survey; thence S. 45 E. 54 poles to three White Oaks from one root corner to said Survey; thence S. 19 E. 26 poles to two White Oaks corner to said Survey; thence East 36 poles to two White Oaks corner to said Survey; thence S. 87 E. 124 poles to two Hickories and a small Black Oak in the West line of John Haine's Survey No. 4408; thence binding thereon N. 12 W. 17 poles to a White Oak corner to said Survey; thence North 105 poles to a White Oak corner to said Survey; thence N. 10 E. 186 poles to five White Oaks and a Hickory, Northwesterly corner to said Survey and Southwesterly corner to said Fulton's said

Survey; thence N. 5 E. 229 poles crossing the fork at 98 poles to a Bur Oak, corner to Fulton's said Survey; thence N. 20 E. 82 poles to two Hickories from one root, Northwesterly corner to said Survey; thence North 165 poles to the beginning.
