

The following description is for a parcel of land in the State of Ohio, Darby Township in Madison County and Jerome Township in Union County, V.M.S. 5167, and is part of a 106.31 acre tract recorded in deed book 151, page 329 in Madison County and deed book 193, page 175 in Union County, said parcel being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a set iron spike on the centerline of the Warner Road (Township Road No. 134 in Madison County and Township Road No. 6 in Union County) at the northwesterly corner of the aforementioned 106.31 acre tract and the northeasterly corner of a 89.9831 acre tract surveyed during this particular field survey, said set iron spike also being in the easterly line of V.M.S. 3743 and the westerly line of V.M.S. 5767; thence along the centerline of Warner Road N 56~59'04" E 780.17 feet to a found iron monument, and being on line with a found iron monument in the westerly right-of-way line of the N.Y.C. Railroad at 1759.83 ft.; thence with a westerly line of a 74.80 acre tract recorded in Madison County in deed book 153, page 409 in the name of William M. and Dorothy L. Thomas, S 34°11'50" E 1761.08 feet to a concrete post in the northerly line of John H. Yoder's 148.49 acre tract as recorded in deed book 151. page 306 in Madison County, and passing the Madison and Union County Line at 1507.83 feet; thence along Yoder's northerly line S 56°24'45" W 776.71 feet to a concrete post at the southeasterly corner of the aforementioned 89.9831 acre survey, and also in the easterly line of V.M.S. 3743 and the westerly line of v.M.S. 5167; thence along the said V.M.S. lines and the easterly line of the 89.9831 acre tract N 34°18'20" W 1768.91 feet to the point of beginning, passing the Madison and Union County Line at 780.40 feet and a concrete post at 1743.22 feet.

The above described parcel contains 31.5366 acres, with 9.2189 acres in Madison County and 22.3177 acres in Union County. The reference bearing is N 89°40'00" W, which is the bearing of the County Line (by original records). The original plat of this survey, showing the found original County Stones and other found monuments, is on permanent file in the Madison County Plat Map Department.
