Beginning at a Railroad Spike in the center of a concrete bridge and center of Thomas Road, Township Road No. 121, at the Northwest corner of said 20.54 acre tract, Deed Book 196, page 380. Said point also being the Southwest corner of a 112 acre tract as conveyed to Elizabeth Jane and Roger D. Snyder, Deed Book 241, page 204.

Thence from said true point of beginning South  $86^{\circ}$  54' 21" East a distance of 261.66 feet along the North line of said 20.54 acre tract, Deed Book 196, page 380, and South line of said 112 acre tract, to an iron pin.

Thence South 40 28' West a distance of 244.59 feet to an iron pin.

Thence North  $87^{\,0}$  40' West a distance of 259.75 feet to a Railroad spike in the center of Thomas Road, passing an iron pin at 239.75 feet.

Thence North  $4^{\circ}$  OO' East a distance of 248.00 feet along the centerline of said Thomas Road, also being along the West line of said 20.54 acre tract, and East line of a 45.72 acre tract as conveyed to Margaret B. Persinger, Life Estate, Deed Book 248, page 577, to place of beginning containing 1.473 acres.
