

The following is a correct description of a field survey made in September, 1986 of 5.0815 acres of land of which 2.5528 arcs are within VMS 5795 Paint Township and 1.1027 acres are within VMS 8749 Paint Township and 1.4215 acres are within VMS 8749 of Union Township...all in Madison County, State of Ohio..... being a portion of First Tract and being a portion of Second Tract as described in Deed Volume 184 at Page 24....subsequently having been conveyed to Loval Gene Clemmons on September 16, 1986 and recorded September 17, 1986 in Deed Volume 270 at Page 233 & 234 of the deed records of Madison County....shown on the Tax Duplicate as Parcel # 14-00210 Paint Township and Parcel # 29-00505 Union Township said 5.0815 acres consisting of the residence, outbuildings and fenced lots at 420 Deck Road, London, Ohio 43140...bounded and more particularly described as follows:

Commence as a point of starting reference with a steel spike reset in the centerlines of Danville Road (Co.Rd. # 8) and Yankeetown-Chenoweth Road (Co.Rd. # 9) in Print Township...said spike being the southwesterly corner of 21.45 acres recorded in Vol. 248 at Page 217....then with the middle of Yankeetown-Chenoweth Road S 85 deg 30 min 00 sec E a measured distance of 1,507.590 feet to a 3/8 inch by 10 inch steel spike set at the southwesterly corner of the herein described 5.0815 acres and being the true point of beginning:

Thence: N 05 deg 30 min 00 sec W (passing a 3/4 inch pipe set at 27.00 feet) a distance of 275.130 feet to a 3/4 inch pipe set near the northerly side of a wood corner post at a fence corner;

Thence: N 82 deg 16 min 00.5 sec E (crossing the east boundary of VMS 5795 and the west boundary of VMS 8749 at 355.155 feet and then crossing the common boundary between Paint and Union Townships at 518.052 feet) a total distance of 675.428 feet to a 3/4 inch pipe set;

Thence: Following a board fence existing....S 08 deg 22 min 58 sec E (passing a 3/4 inch pipe set at 305.080 feet) a total distance of 318.990 feet to a 3/8 inch by 10 inch steel spike set....which spike bears S 76 deg 48 min 00 sec W 326.500 feet from a steel pipe found...said spike and pipe on the southerly boundary of VMS 8749 located in Deck Road (Typ. Rd. # 144);

Thence: With the aforesaid VMS boundary and running along the northerly edge of roadway pavement..... 76 deg 48 min 00 sec W (crossing the line between Paint Township and Union Township at 221.243 feet) a total distance of 339.130 feet to a 3/8 inch by 10 inch steel spike set at the common corner of VMS 8922, VMS 8749 and VMS 5795...said spike being the southeasterly corner of Tract # 2 and being the southwesterly corner of Tract # 1 recorded in Volume 184 at Page 24 and Volume 270 at Pages 233 & 234;

Thence: N 85 deg 30 min 00 sec W (passing a 3/8 inch-by 10 inch steel spike set at the centerline tangents of Deck Road and Yankeetown-Chenoweth Road at 106.720 feet) and then with the centerline tangent of Yankeetown-Chenoweth Road a total distance of 360.360 feet to the true point of beginning.

The above described premises contains 5.0815 acres of land in Paint Township and in Union Township. (3.6600 acres in Paint Township and 1.4215 acres in Union Township)

Bearings have been based on the S 05 deg 30 min E course along the westerly side of Tract # 2 as described in Volume 184 at Page 24 and subsequently recorded in Volume 270 at Pages 233 & 234.

Current Tax Parcel in Paint Township is #14-00210 (19,30 acres) and #29-00505 is carried as 14.380 acres in Union Township.

Note: The present Deck Road incorporates a former laneway which was known at Robert Armstrong Lane or Robert Armstrong Road...the width apparently varies from 1 feet to approxiamtely 22 feet...however the present Deck Road is reported to be 50 feet wide and Yankeetown-Chenoweth Road is reported to be 50 feet wide
