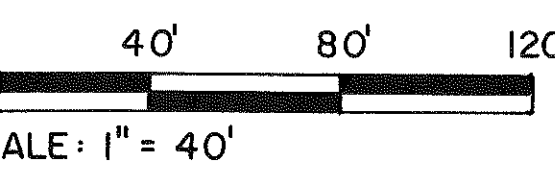
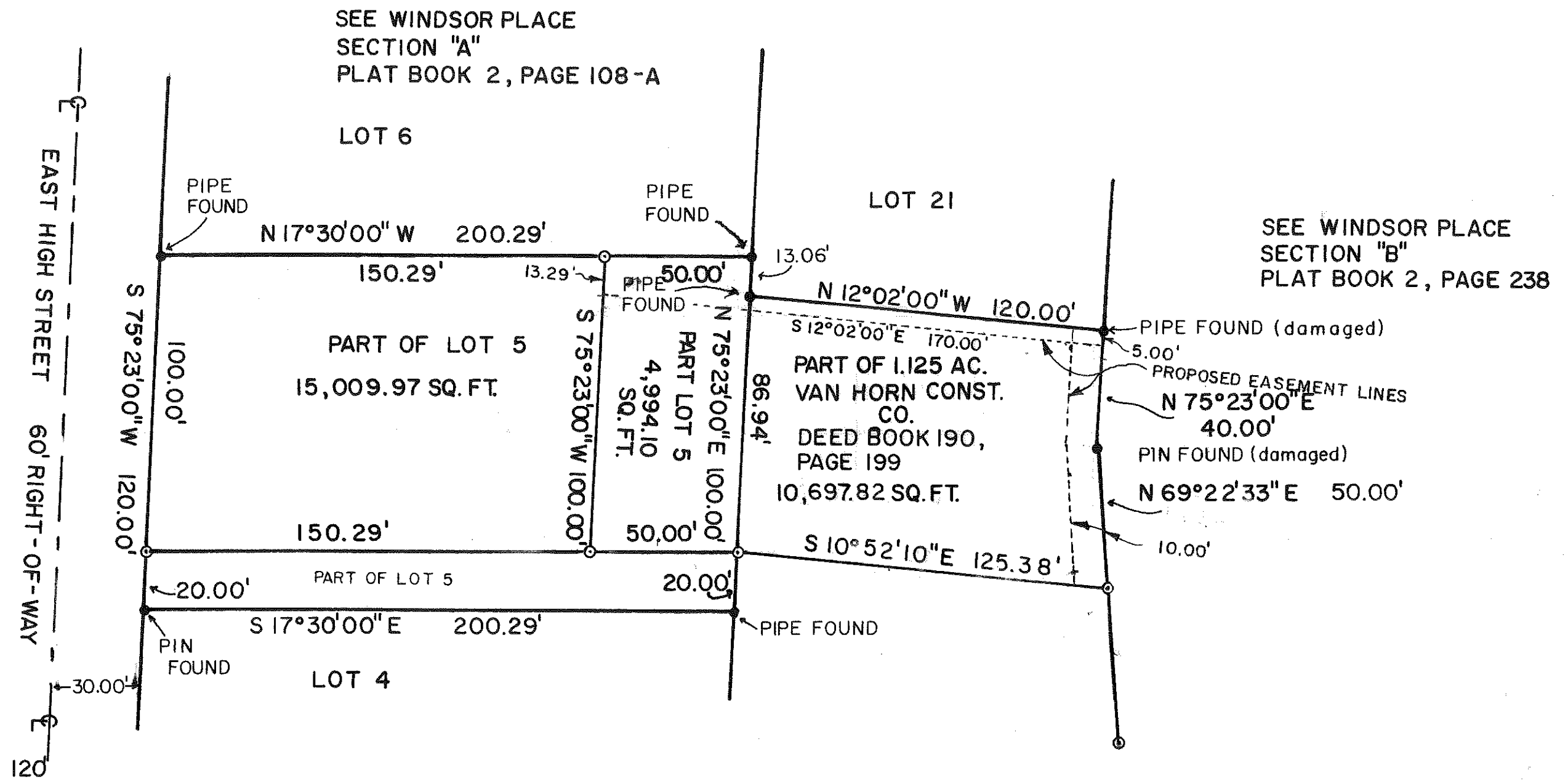


⊙-INDICATES IRON PIPE SET.



The following description is for a part of the southern portion of Lot 5 of the Windsor Place Subdivision Section "A" as recorded in Plat Book 2, page 108-A in the Madison County Recorder's Office: Beginning at the southeasterly corner of Lot 6 in the northerly right-of-way line of East High Street and a found iron pipe; thence along the easterly line of Lot 6 N 17°30'00" W 150.29 feet to a set iron pipe; thence N 75°23'00" E 100.00 feet to a set iron pipe; thence S 17°30'00" E 150.29 feet to a set iron pipe in the northerly line of East high Street; thence along the northerly line of East High Street S 75°23'00" W 100.00 feet to the point of beginning.
