The following description is for a parcel of land in the State of Chio, County of Madison, Township of Somerford, Virginia Military Survey Number 6014, and is part of a 170.642 acre tract and part of 58.186 acre tract recorded in the name of William and Ann Ward in Deed Book 270, pages 770 & 774, said parcel being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a found iron spike in the in the centerline of State Route 56(60' R/W), said spike being in the southerly line of said Ward and the northwesterly corner of a 7.322 acre tract recorded in the name of Richard Olsen in Deed Book 265, page 69;

Thence, with the centerline of State Route 56, N 37°28'18" W(reference bearing in accordance with Deed Book 270, page 774) 295.87 feet to a point, said point being the true point of beginning;

Thence, continuing with said centerline, N 37°28'18" W 295.88 feet to a point;

Thence N 52°21'11" E, passing a set iron pipe at 30.00 feet, a total distance of 1183.01 feet to a set iron pipe;

Thence S 37°28'18" E 295.88 feet to a iron pipe set;

Thence S 52°21'11" W, passing a found iron pipe at 1153.01 feet, a total distance of 1183.01 feet to the <u>true</u> point of beginning.
