

Situated in the State of Ohio, County of Madison, City of London, in part of V.M.S. 8886, and being out of an existing 1.354 acre tract in the name of Four-In-One, A Partnership, as recorded in deed book 236, page 244, said parcel being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a found iron monument on the centerline of Elm Street at the northwest corner of a 1.996 acre tract in the name of Four-In-One, A Partnership (recorded in deed book 204, page 349) and the southwest corner of a 12.398 acre tract in the name of The Most Reverened Edward J. Herrmann, Bishop of Columbus (recorded in deed book 217, page 291) thence along the southerly side of the aforementioned 12.398 acre tract N. 74°53'40" E. 1191.90 feet to a set iron pipe at the northeast corner of a 1.69 acre tract in the name of Surrey Square III, Ltd. (recorded in deed book 236, page 248) and the northwest corner of the aforementioned 1.354 acre tract and the true point of beginning; thence along the southerly side of the 12,398 acre tract N. 74°53'40" E. 164.65 feet to a found fron pin in a westerly line of a 54.719 acre tract in the name of Neil Babb (recorded in deed book 237, page 368); thence along the westerly line of Babb S. 15°53'26" E. 257.96 feet to a set iron pipe (being on line with a found iron pin in the westerly line of Babb and the northerly line of a 38.111 acre tract in the name of Paul Andrix, at 344.63', deed book 237, page 402); thence S. 74°54'08" W. 173.19 feet to a set iron pipe in the easterly line of the aforementioned 1.69 acre tract in the name of Surrey Square III, Ltd.; thence along the easterly line of the 1.69 acre tract N. 13°59'42" W. 257.96 feet to the true point of beginning.

The above described parcel contains 1.000 acres. The reference bearing is N.74°53'40' E. and iron pipes set are 3/4 inches in diameter by 30 inches in length with aluminum caps marked P.S. 5969. Surveyed by Neil Babb, P.S. 5969, December of 1980.
