

Description of 3.2086 Acre Tract

Situated in the State of Ohio, Madison County, Union Township, V.M.S. 8846 and being part of a 149.1606 acre tract conveyed to Mary E. Hammond by Deed Book 274 Page 663 and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a railroad spike found at an angle point in the centerline of State Route 56 (60 foot right-of-way) said spike found at the Southeast corner of 2.4970 acre tract conveyed to First Church of God by Deed Book 246 Page 263;

Thence, with the centerline of State Route 56 South 48 deg. 15 min. 00 sec. East a distance of 261.36 feet to a point in said centerline;

Thence, with the following two new lines across said 149.1606 acre tract;

- 1) South 17 deg. 00 min. 00 sec. West passing an iron pin and cap set at 33.03 feet, a total distance of 323.48 feet to an iron pin and cap set
- 2) North 52 deg. 24 min 37 sec. West a distance of 470.49 feet to a 3/4 inch iron pipe and yellow plastic cap stamped "RET 6552" found at the Southern most corner of a 1.8440 acre tract conveyed to David Manning by Deed Book 286 Page 596;

Thence, with the Southeast line of said 1.8440 acre tract North 21 deg. 35 min. 15 sec. East passing an iron pin and yellow plastic cap stamped "RET 6552" found at 254.97 feet, a total distance of 283.69 feet to an iron pin and cap set in the Southwest line of said 2.4970 acre tract;

Thence; with the West line of said said 3.0000 acre tract South 16 deg. 40 min. 16 sec. West passing an iron pin and cap set at 30.00 feet a total distance of 307.09 feet to a 5/8 inch diameter iron pin found at the Southwest corner of said 3.0000 acre tract and the Northwest corner of 41.404 acre tract conveyed to Russell Viney by beed Book 213 Page 517;

Thence, with the following two new lines across said 149.1606 acre tract:

- 1) North 52 deg. 24 min. 37 sec. West a distance of 483.42 feet to an iron pin and cap set
