Neal estate situated in the Village of Plain City; in Darby Township of Madison County, Ohio; in the Virginia Military Survey Number 8999; being a more particular description of the 5.58 acretract of Alice Marie Hostetler (Deed Record 263, Page 223); and being further bounded and described as follows:

Beginning for reference at a railroad spike found in the centerline of Perry Pike (County Road 40) at the East line of said V.M.S. 8999. Said spike being approximately 57.5 feet West of the centerline of U.S. Route 42 (60' right-of-way).

Thence South 01º 38' 10", West, 216.94 feet with said V.M.S. line to an iron pin found marking the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING.

Thence South 01° 44′ 00° West, 785.56 feet continuing with said V.M.S. line and the West line of the 0.8678 acre tract of MEDCO Properties, Inc. (Deed Record 272, Page 318) to an iron pipe set on a North line of the Dale W. Stewart Subdivision (Plat Book 02, Page 211). Said iron pipe being 19.29 feet left of station 1301 + 42.46 of the centerline of aforesaid U.S Route 42 (according to R/W plan MAD-42-22.35-24.64, sheet 4 of 4).

Thence with two consecutive courses of said subdivision also owned by said MEDÇO Properties, Inc. (Deed Record 272, Page 318):

1) South 84° 10' 36" West, 299.53 feet to an iron pin found. 2) North 01° 33' 13" East, 848.58 feet to an iron pin found at the southwest corner of the 0.688 acre tract of MEDCO Properties, Corporation (Deed Record 263, Page 439).

Thence South 83° 51' 51" East, 135.43 feet with the South line of said 0.688 acre tract to an iron pin found at the southwest corner of the 0.049 acre tract of Lee Roy and Louella Mast (Deed Record 293, Page 218).

Thence South 83° 40' 25" East, 165.10 feet with the South lines of said 0.049 acre tract and the 0.739 acre tract also owned by said Mast (same Deed reference) to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING.

Bearing assumed from said center line of U.S. Noute 42 R/W plans. The tract as described from an actual field survey performed on or about May 19, 1994, by Registered Surveyor Joseph P. Priday (S-7277), contains 5.596 acres, more or less, subject to all previous easements and right-of-way of record. All iron pipes set are 3/4 X 30° galvanized pipe with plastic I.D. caps. the plat survey is recorded in the office of the Madison County Engineer.
