

Situated in the County of Madison, State of Ohio and Township of Jefferson, and bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a railroad spike found in the centerline of Plain City-Georgesville Road at the northeast corner of a 5.642 acre parcel in the name of Robert and Connie Murry, (D.B. 283, P. 763);

thence S 5 deg. 02'52" E, 291.95 feet, along the centerline of Plain City-Georgesville Road to a railroad spike found;

thence S 4 deg. 34'28"E, 13.00 feet along the centerline of the road, to a PK nail found at the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING;

thence S 75 deg. 40'37"W, 740.29 feet, passing over a pin found at 25.04 feet, to the east line of VMS 2445 and a 604.3834 acre tract in the name of Murray Farms, Ltd. (D.B. 257, P. 46), to a pin found;

thence S 33 deg. 16'31" E, 261.00 feet along the east line of the said 604.3834 acre tract and the west line of the said 3.8349 acre parcel to a pin set;

thence N 75 deg. 40'37" E, 613.03 feet, into the said 12.658 acre tract, passing over a pin set in the right of way line of Plain City-Georgesville Road at 588.03 feet, to the centerline of Plain City-Georgesville Road to a PK nail set;

thence N 4 deg. 33'24" W, 250.48 feet, along the centerline of Plain City-Georgesville Road to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING;
