Nº 30-A SCALE: 1": 40" Property boundary description of 21,533.6 square feet of land or 0.494 acre in VMS 10081-10605-10984-10858 & 12172, Canaan Civil Township, Madison County, State of Ohio, being a portion of 49.3294 acres in the name of Marvin L. Kurtz and Wilma M. Kurtz of record in OR 003, Pg. 0351, said 0.494 acre is bounded and more particularly described as follows:

From a steel spike and iron pin existing in the centerline junction of Amish Pike (Co. Rd. # 30-A) and Kaufman Road (Twp. Rd. # 153)...then with the middle of Amish Pike N 42 deg 00 min 00 sec E 113.20 feet to a set P.K. spike at the true point of beginning;

Thence: Passing a found 3/4 inch capped pipe at 27.57 feet, N 85 deg $48 \min 50 \sec W$ 344.220 feet to a found 3/4 inch capped iron pipe at the base of a wood corner post and fence junction;

Thence: Following an existing wire fence N 20 deg 11 min 48 sec E 62.421 feet to a set 3/4 inch capped iron pipe;

Thence: Passing a set 3/4 inch pipe at 50 sec E 373.567 feet to a P.K. spike set in the middle of Amish Pike;

the centerline thereof S 42 deg 00 min 00 sec W 75.949 feet to the true point of

Containing within said bounds a total of 0.494 acre of which 0.044 acre is in the present public highway right of way. Being a portion of permanent parcel # 01-00584. This premises is not in a flood zone, it is not intended for a building site but rather is to be used for purposes of parking lot expansion. Bearings are based on Volume 259 at page 388. Pipes set are 3/4 inch with caps stamped R.I. Baker S-5539. This description is based on a current field survey made in February and March, 1995 by the undersigned surveyor Rodger Irwin Baker.
