

The following description is for a tract of land in the State of Ohio, County of Madison, Township of Jefferson, and Village of West Jefferson, Virginia Military Survey Numbers 2836 and 2445, and is part of a 604.383 acre tract recorded in the name of Murray Parms Ltd. in Deed Book 257, Page 46, said parcel being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pipe in the easterly line of the Village of West Jefferson Sewage Disposal plant as recorded in Deed Book 186, Page 157 and listed as containing 3.65 acres; thence

North 30° 27' 57" West, 302.25 feet to a found wooden post at the corner of a 219 acre tract recorded in the name of Harriet Norcott in Deed Book 284, Page 165; thence with the lines of said Norcott,

North 26° 58' 35" East, 1248.06 feet to a found iron pipe; thence

North 44" 59' 59" East, 786.83 feet to a found iron pipe and stone on the east side of a Mill Race and the northwest side of Little Darby Creek (formerly the T. Cartmill "Oakridge Flouring Mill" Race, see Deed Book 42, Page 360), passing the intersection of the Corporation line of the Village of West Jefferson at 728.43 feet; thence with the line of Norcott, the east bank of the Mill Race and the southeast corporation line of said Village of West Jefferson.

North 12° 36' 46' East, 478.98 feet to a found iron pipe at the southwest corner of a 2.50 acre tract recorded in the name of the Village of West Jefferson, as referenced in the Court of Common Pleas "Complete Record" 30, Page 283 (originally a site for a sewage plant and now an abandoned trash dump); thence with the lines of said 2.50 acre tract, South 74" 32' 08" East, 267.00 feet to a found iron pipe; thence

North 14° 27' 04" East, 409.36 feet to a found iron pipe (damaged); thence North 74° 32' 08" West, 260.25 feet to a found iron pipe in

the easterly line of the aforementioned Norcott; thence along said easterly line, the east Corporation line, and the east bank of the Mill Race,

North 16° 52' 82" East, 31.02 feet to a found iron pipe; thence

North 32° 32' 57" East. 225.84 feet to a found iron pipe at the point of intersection of the corporation line of the Village of West Jefferson (the corporation line bears North 25° 00' 40" East); thence

North 06° 31' 35" East, 792.00 feet to a found iron pipe at the northeast corner of a 0.25 acre tract recorded in Deed Book 148, Page 685 in the name of Raymond and Patricia Baugess; thence along the easterly line of Alice Eberhart (as recorded in Deed Book 222, Page 379) and a part of the easterly line of a 0.300 acre tract recorded in Deed Book 230, Page 180 in the name of Charles and Hilda Hillberry, North 10° 53' 49" East, 169.60 feet to a found iron "tee" bar, passing the northeast corner of Hillberry at 149.76 feet and a found iron pipe (east of line by 0.21 feet); thence along a southerly line of a 1.790 acre tract recorded in Deed Book 251, Page 346 in the name of the Mallco Corporation, and the northerly line of the Murray Farms, South 85° 53' 07" East, 300.08 feet to a found iron pipe;

thence

South 84° 10' 40" East, 500.17 feet to a point, passing a found iron pipe at 12.83 feet marking the easterly corporation line of the Village of West Jefferson; thence South 18° 54' 36" West, 1049.96 feet to a point in the centerline of Little Darby Creek, said point bearing South 58° 31' 45" East, 87.84 feet from an iron pipe; thence with said centerline,

South 68° 31' 45" East, 500.54 feet to a point, said point bearing South 30° 45' 18" West, 78.63 feet from an iron pipe; thence

South 30° 45' 18' West, 550.00 feet to a point, said point bearing South 75° 46' 00" West, 62.25 feet from an iron pipe; thence

South 75° 48' 00" West, 1003.35 feet to a point, said point bearing South 50° 10' 33" East, 100.00 feet from a found iron pipe; thence

South 40° 10' 33" West, 1147.88 feet to an iron pipe on the west bank of Little Darby creek; thence South 08° 32' 00" West, 450.00 feet to a point on the

centerline of said creek, said point bearing South 62° 00' 00" West, 97.62 feet from an iron pipe: thence with said centerline,

South 62° 00' 00" West, 105.49 feet to a point, said point bearing South 01° 25' 00" East, 75.58 feet from an iron pipe; thence

South 01° 25' 00" East, 498.89 feet to a point; thence South 59° 32' 03" West, passing a set iron pipe at 75.00 feet, a total distance of 250.00 feet to the point of beginning, containing 41.630 acres, more or less, and being 3.566 acres in the Village of West Jefferson and 38.064 acres in the Township of Jefferson, and is subject to all legal rights of way and easements of record including a blanket gas line easement of record in Deed Book 70, Page 595, an outfall sewer and drainage ditch easement of record in Deed Book 156, Page 49, and a sewer line right of way, and a trunk sewer and ingress and egress easement of record in Complete Record 30, Page 283, Madison County Common Pleas Court records. All Deed Books mentioned are those in the Recorders Office, Madison County, Ohio. This description is based on a 1981 survey by Neil Babb Registered Professional Surveyor No. 5969 and a December 1994 survey by William W. Browning Registered Surveyor No. 7377. A triangular subtraction of 1.761 acres was made from the Browning, December 1994 survey and description, by The Thomas Engineering & Surveying Co., in February, 1995, and has been excluded from the above description and acreage.
