

The following described 0.3126 acre tract is situated in the State of Ohio, Madison County, Jefferson Township, V.M.S. 2445, and being part of a 1.601 acre tract conveyed to Wilbur F. and Patricia A. Kay by Deed Book 185 Page 215 and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a 3/4 inch iron T bar and cap found at the Northern most corner of a 0.907 acre tract conveyed to Roger A. and Cynthia Askey by Deed Book 288 Page 550 said T bar bears North 55 deg. 54 min. 00 sec. East, a distance of 435.60 feet from a railroad spike found in the centerline of Olmstead Road (County Road 51) (50 foot right-of-way) said railroad spike is at the southern most corner of said 1.601 acre tract and the Northwest corner of said 0.907 acre tract;

Thence, with a new line across said 1.601 acre tract North 55 deg. 54 min. 00 sec. East a distance of 124.01 feet to an iron pin and cap set in the Northeast line of said 1.601 acre tract also being the West line of a 32.164 acre tract conveyed to Claris E. Jones by Deed Book 286 page 879;

Thence, with said 32.164 acre tract the following two courses:

- 1) South 26 deg. 41 min. 00 sec. East a distance of 12.33 feet to a 3/4 inch iron T bar and cap found
- 2) South 2 deg. 05 min. 48 sec. East, passing a deep ravine a total distance of 233.15 feet to a 3/4 T bar and cap found at the eastern most corner of said 0.907 acre tract

Thence, with the Northeast line of said 0.907 acre tract North 33 deg. 47 min. 16 sec. West a distance of 209.94 feet to the point of beginning containing 0.3126 acres more or less.

The here-in-above described 0.3126 acre tract is to become part of and contigent to said Askey 0.907 acre tract.

Bearings are based on the centerline of Olmstead Road (North 33 deg. 35 min. West) as described in Deed Book 185 Page

This deed is subject to and with the benefit of all legal highways, restrictions, easements, limitations, and reservations, of record, if any and to zoning restrictions which have been imposed thereon, if any.

All iron pins set are 5/8 inch diameter rebar with yellow plastic caps stamped "Cottrill 6858".
