Beginning at PK nail previously set in the centerline of State Route 56 said Pk nail is at the Northwest corner of a 20.0015 acre tract conveyed to Gerald L. Reynolds and Dawn Roy by Official Record 26 Page 562 said Pk nail is also the Northeast corner of said 33.8478 acre tract;

Thence, with the Northwest line of said 20,0015 acre tract South 35 deg. 22 min. 00 sec. West, passing an iron pin and cap previously set at 79.77 feet, and a 573.49 feet, also passing an iron pin and cap set 747.20 feet, a total distance of 827.20 feet to an iron pin and cap set on the South bank of Walnut Run;

Thence, across said 33.8478 acre tract the following two new courses:

- 1) North 41 deg. 43 min. 15 sec. West, crossing Walnut Run, a total distance 270.68 feet to an iron pin and cap set
- 2) North 35 deg. 22 min. 00 sec. East, passing an iron pin and cap set at 147.77 feet, and also at 747.19 feet, a total distance of 824.06 feet to a point in the centerline of State Route 56;

Thence, with said centerline the following two courses:

- 1) South 41 deg. 43 min. 15 sec. East a distance of 21.97 feet to a PK nail set at an angle point in said centerline
- 2) South 42 deg. 25 min. 39 sec. East a distance of 248.03 feet to the point of beginning containing 5.0000 acres more or less.

Thance, across said 33.8478 acre tract the following three new lines:

- 1) South 35 deg. 22 min. 00 sec. West, passing an iron pin and cap set at 78.82 feet, a total distance of 676.29 feet to an iron pin and cap set
- 2) South 41 deg. 43 min. 15 sec. East being parallel to the centerline of State Route 56 a total distance of 225.43 feet to an iron pin and cap set
- 3) North 35 dag. 22 min. 00 sec. East, passing an iron pin and cap set at 599.42 feet, a total distance of 676.29 feet to a the centerline of State Route 56;

Thence, across said 33.8478 acre tract the following three new courses:

- 1) South 35 dag. 22 min. 00 sec. West, passing an Iron pin and cap set at 78.82 feet a total distance of 676.29 feet to an iron pin and cap set
- 2) North 41 deg. 43 min. 15 sec. West being parallel to the centerline of State Route 56 a distance of 196.51 feet to an iron pin and cap set
