

Being part of Virginia Military Survey Number 3275, and part of Lot 192 of the Choctaw Lake Subdivision as recorded in Plat Book 2, pages 19-23, said parcel being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a found iron pipe in the right-of-way of Choctaw Circle (60' R/W) and at the southeast corner of Lot 192 and the northeast corner of Lot 191;

Thence, with the line between said Lot 191 and Lot 192, S 60° 30' 00" W 245.00 feet to found iron pipe at the southwest corner of Lot 192;

Thence N 56° 29' 00" W 40.00 feet to a set iron pipe;

Thence, with a new division line of Lot 192, N 68° 12' 51" E 265.55 feet to the point of beginning.

This excepted parcel contains 0.100 acres (4367 S.F.). The original plat of this survey is on permanent file in the Madison County Tax Map Department. Surveyed by William W. Browning, P. S. 7377, during October of 1995.
