

TRACT ONE: Situated in Virginia Military Survey No. 8751, Township of Oak Run, County of Madison, State of Ohio. Being a part of a 5.3269 acre tract as conveyed to Dean and Faith Marshall as recorded in Deed Book 264, Page 634, Madison County, Ohio records and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin found in the center of Van Wagener Road

at the Southeast corner of said 5.3269 acre tract.

Thence North 85 deg. 50' 00" West a distance of 288.58 feet along the South line of said 5.3269 acre tract to an iron pin, passing an iron pin at 30.00 feet.

Thence North 03 deg. 10' 49" East a distance of 150.00 feet to an iron pin.

Thence South 85 deg. 50' 00" East a distance of 288.58 feet to a Railroad spike in the center of said Van Wagener Road, passing an iron pin at 258.58 feet.

Thence South 03 deg. 10' 49" West a distance of 150.00 feet along the centerline of said Van Wagener Road to place of beginning containing 0.9937 acre. Known as 7164 Van Wagener Road.

TRACT TWO: Situated in Virginia Military Survey No. 8751, Township of Oak Run, County of Madison, State of Ohio. Being part of a 5.3269 acre tract as conveyed to Dean and Faith Marshall as recorded in Deed Book 264, Page 634, Madison County, Ohio records and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a Railroad spike in the center of Van Wagener Road at the Northeast corner of said 5.3269 acre tract. Thence South 03 deg. 10' 49" West a distance of 150.00 feet along the centerline of said Van Wagener Road to a Railroad spike.

Thence North 81 deg. 08' 40" West a distance of 290.00 feet to an iron pin, passing an iron pin at 30.12 feet.

Thence North 03 deg. 10' 49" East a distance of 150.00 feet to an iron pin on the North line of said 5.3269 acre tract.

South 81 deg. 08' 40" East a distance of 290.00 feet passing an iron pin at 259.88 feet to place of beginning containing 0.9937 acre.

TRACT THREE: Situated in Virginia Military Survey No. 8751, Township of Oak Run, County of Madison, State of Ohio. Being a part of a 5.3269 acre tract as conveyed to Dean and Faith Marshall as recorded in Deed Book 264, Page 634, Madison County, Ohio records and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a Railroad spike in the center of Van Wagener Road, which is referenced as being South 03 deg. 10' 49" West a distance of 150.00 feet, measured along the centerline of said Van Wagener Road from a Railroad spike at the Northeast corner of said 5.3269 acre

tract, Deed Book 264, Page 634.

Thence from said true point of beginning South 03 deg. 10' 49" West a distance of 31.00 feet along the centerline of said Van Wagener Road to a Railroad spike.

Thence North 85 deg. 50' 00" West a distance of 288.58 feet to an iron pin, passing an iron pin at 30.00 feet.

Thence South 03 deg. 10' 49" West a distance of 150.00 feet to an iron pin on the South line of said 5.3269 acre tract.

Thence North 85 deg. 50' 00" West a distance of 355.42 feet along the South line of said 5.3269 acre tract to an iron pin at the Southwest corner of said 5.3269 acre tract.

Thence North 01 deg. 43' 29" East a distance of 385.00 feet along the entire West line of said 5.3269 acre tract to an iron pin at the Northwest corner of said 5.3269 acre tract

. Thence South 81 deg. 08' 40" East a distance of 366.90 feet along the North line of said 5.3269 acre tract to an iron pin.

Thence South 03 deg. 10' 49" West a distance of 150.00 feet to an iron pin.

Thence South $\bar{8}1$ deg. 08' 40" East a distance of 290.00 feet, passing an iron pin at 259.88 feet, to place of beginning containing 3.3396 acres.

Note: Tract Three is a non building site.
