

1,843 Acres Tract A

Beginning at a found iron pin at the north corner of said Let 529 and the south corner of Let 652 and in the easterly line of the abovestated 231.00 acre tract; Thence, with two new lines of the aforesaid London School Foundation, S 89°38'00" W 140.69 feet to a set Iron pipe and S 07°13'45" E 504,54 feet to an iron pin found a the common corner between Let 529 and 528;

Thence, with the line betweened the last named lots, S 79°37'00" E 177.70 feet to an found iron pin marking said common corners and being in the 35 ' Right-of-Way of Choctaw Drive;

Thence, with said right-of-line, N10°22'00" W 542.30 feet to the point of beginning.

Beginning at a found iron pin at the north corner of said Lot 529 and the south corner of Lot 652 and in the easterly line of the apovestated 231.00 acre tract; Thence, with two new lines of the aforesaid London School Foundation, S 89"38'00" W 140.69 feet to a set iron pipe and N 07°13'45" W 208.25 feet to an iron pin found a the common corner between Lot 652 and 653;

Thonce, with the line between the last named lots, N 82°08'00" E 186.81 feet to an found iron pin marking the 35 Right-of-Way of Choctaw Drive;

Thence, with a curve A=214.5 feet Ch = \$ 05°53'54" W 211.61 feet to a found iron pipe on the curve of the aftersaid right-of-way line

Thence, with said right-of-way S10°17'44" E 21.21 feet to the point of beginning.
