

Situated in the State of Ohio, County of Madison
and Township of Pleasant
Being part of the First and Second Tracts conveyed to Ropert P. Ruble and
Marilyn R. Dougnerty (Deed Volume 256, Page 77 Madison County Deed Records),
pounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a Mag-Nail set in the center of Robinson Road (County Road No. 62) in the north line of the First Tract of which this is a part, said Magnail bears, N. 71 deg. 31' 36" E. 1856.70 ft. from a P-K nail found at the intersection of the center of Robinson Road and State Route 56; thence with

the center of Robison. Road, N. 70 deg. 22' 00" E. 72.76 ft. to a P-K nail found at the northwest corner of the 1.00 acre tract conveyed to Daniel E. and Victoria L. Fryer (Deed Vol. 233, Page 176); thence with the West, south and east line of Fryer's 1.00 acre tract the following (3) courses:

- S. 19 deg. 38' 00" E. 208.75 ft. to an iron pin set, passing an iron pipe found at 22.43 ft.,
- 2. N. 70 deg. 22' 00" E. 200.68 ft. to an iron pin set and
- 3. N. 15 deg. 16' 00" W. 209.36 ft. to a Mag-Nail set in the center of Robison Road, passing an iron pin set at 179.36 ft.; thence continuing with the north lines of the First and Second Tracts of which this is a part and with the center of Robison Road, N. 70 deg. 22' 00" E. 1110.62 ft. to a Nag-Nail set, passing the southwest corner of the 3.5954 acre tract conveyed to Patrick B. and Gail A. Oravec (Deed Vol. 293, Page 372) at 755.52 ft., said nail bears S. 70 deg. 22' 00" W. 64.26 ft. from a small railroad spike found at the southeast corner of Oravec's 3.6954 acre tract; thence with new lines through the tract ofwnich this is a part the following (3) courses:
- 1. S. 19 deg. 38' 00'' E. a total distance of 700.00 ft. to an iron pin set, passing an iron pin set at 30.00 ft.,
- 2. S. 70 deg. 22' 00" W. 1400.00 ft. to an iron pin set and
- 3. N. 19 deg. 38' 00" w. 700.00 ft. to the point of beginning, passing an iron pin set at 670.00 ft., containing 21.498 acres, subject to all easements and rights-of-way for Robison Road.

Being a part of Virginia Military Survey No. 1315.

Being 12.190 acres of the First Tract and 9.308 acres of the Second Tract of the grantors merein (Deed Vol. 256, Page 77).

This legal description is based on a field survey performed March 28, 1997 under the direction and supervision of Michael T. Slagle, Ohio Professional Surveyor No. 6699. The magnetic bearings in this legal description are based on the South line of Oravec's 3.6954 acre tract (N. 70 deg. 22' 00" E.) and are used solely for the purpose of denoting angles. All iron pins set by this surveyor are 5/8 inch diameter, 30 inches long with an identification cap labeled Slagle S-6699, unless otherwise indicated.
