

Situated in the State of Chio, in both Township of Union, the County of Madison/and the City of London, VMS 8742, being part of an 8.077 acre parcel and part of a 43.652 acre parcel in the name of Richard E. Flax, Deed Book 247, Pages 552-554 and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a found iron pin in the southerly right-of-way line of the CON-RAIL railroad, said point also being the intersection of said right-of-way and the easterly line, extended northerly of the Westmoor Sub., Block "E", London, Chio, Plat Book 2, Pg. 3, thence with the said right-of-way of CON-RAIL, N. 82 deg. 36' 52" W, 88.92 feet to a set iron pipe and the TRUE point of beginning:

Thence through Flax, S 5 deg 27' 42" W, 157.44 feet to a set iron pipe;

Thence S 70 deg. 19' 05" W, 921.91 feet (passing a found iron pin at 381.91 feet, said pin being the northeast corner of Lot 7, Westmoor Estates Sub.) to a found iron pin at the rear corner, common to Lots 9 and 10 of said subdivision;

Thence with the west line of Westmoor Estates Sub., S 19 deg. 40° 55° E, 603.47 feet to the rear corner, common to Lots 13 and 14 of said subdivision;

Thence through Flax the following four (4) courses:

- S 70 deg. 191 05" W, 20.00 feet to a point;
- S 15 deg. 12' 58" E, 91.25 feet to a point;
- S 44 deg. 18' 09" W, 75.00 feet to a point;
- S 59 deg. 18' 09" W, 60.00 feet to a point in the south line of Flax's 43.652 acre parcel;

Thence with Flax's south line N 75 deg. 41' 51" W, 1207.29 feet to a found iron pin at the southwest corner of said parcel;

Thence with the west line of Flax N 5 deg. 07' 19" E, 1160.05 feet to a found iron pin in the southerly right-of-way of aforementioned railroad;

Thence with said right-of-way S 82 deg. 36' 52" E, 1860.38 feet to the point of beginning. The herein described parcel contains 38.2742 acres and is subject to all right-of-ways and easements of record. Prepared from a field survey done in May, 1989. Roger E. Thompson, Registered surveyor #6552.

Beginning at a found iron pin in the southwest corner of Lot 14, Westmoor Estates Subdivision, City of London and in the line of a 28.24 acre parcel in the name of William D. Christopher, etal., D.B. 251, Pg. 655, thence with the line between Flax and Christopher, N 75 deg. 41' 51" W, 185.00 feet to a point;

The following four lines are new lines through Flax:

Thence N 59 deg. 18' 09" E, 60.00 feet to a point; Thence N 44 deg. 18' 09" E, 75.00 feet to a point; Thence N 15 deg. 12' 58" W, 91.25 feet to a point; Thence N 70 deg. 19' 05" E, 20.00 feet to an iron pin found at the rear corner common to Lots 13 and 14 of Westmoor Estates Subdivision;

Thence along the west lot line of Lot 14, Westmoor Estates Subdivision, S 19 deg. 40' 55" E, 238.74 feet to the point of beginning. The herein described parcel contains 0.3098 acres.
