

Situate, lying and being a part of V.M.S. #7265, #6908, and #6909 in Range Twp., Madison Co., Ohio bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a railroad spike set in centerline of Wissler Rd. (C-10), said railroad spike being S. 27° 44′ 53" W., 1053.63 feet from a railroad spike found at the centerline intersection of Yankeetown-Chenoweth Rd. (C-9) and Wissler Rd. (C-18);

thence S. 67° 13' 25" E., with a wire fence, a new line thru the tract of which this lot is a part, 988.83 feet to an iron pin set at a fence corner post;

thence S. 23° 00' 15" W., with a wire fence, another new line thru the tract of which this lot is a part, 984.76 feet to an iron pin set;

thence N. 63° 01' 33" W., with a wire fence and the south line of the tract of which this lot is a part, 1066.65 feet to a railroad spike set in the centerine of Wissler Rd. (C-18);

thence N. 27° 44′ 53" E. with the centerline of Wissler Rd. (C-18), 910.10 feet to the point or place of beginning and containing 22.319 acres.

And being 22.319 acres out of the 90.0968 acre 3rd Tract conveyed to Corlis K. Clemans by John Sawyer and recorded in Madison County Deed Vol. 165 on Page 491 and Fayette County Deed Vol. 107, Page 237.
