

Situate, lying and being a part of V.M.S. #7265 in Range Twp., Madison Co., Ohio bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a railroad spike at the centerline of Yankeetown-Chenoweth Rd. (C-9) and Kellough Rd. (T-116) and the northeast corner of the tract of which this lot is a part:

thence S. 32° 29' 14" W. with the centerline of Kellough Rd. (T-116), 900.39 feet to a railroad spike set;

thence with the following two new courses of a wire fence; N. 58° 47′ 08" W., 1042 feet to an iron pin set; N. 65° 12′ 18" W., 142.00 feet to an iron pin set;

thence N. 27° 06′ 48" E. with another new line thru the tract of which this lot is a part, 1098.01 feet to a railroad spike set in the centerline of Yankeetown-Chenoweth Rd. (C-9);

thence S. 50° 50' 00" E. with the centerline of Yankeetown-Chenoweth Rd. (C-9), 1295.00 feet to the point or place of beginning and containing 28.002 acres.
