

68.728 Acres

The following description is for a parcel of land in the State of Ohio, County of Madison, Township of Monroe, Virginia Military Survey Numbers 7528 and 12129, and is part of a 20.54 acre tract, all of a 34.94 acre tract and part of a 96.04 acre tract recorded in the name of Louis D. Becker and Phyliss B. Hackett in Deed Book 288, page 695, said parcel being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a found iron spike in the centerline of Thomas Road (40' R/W), said spike being the original northwest corner of the abovementioned 20.54 acre tract and now being the northwest corner of a 1.473 acre tract recorded in the name of Keith & Linda Beachy in Official Record 26, page 799 and the southwest corner of a 112.00 acre tract recorded in the name of Elizabeth and Roger Snyder in Deed Book 241, page 204;

Thence, with the southerly line of said Snyder, S 87 deg. 11' 11" E passing a found iron pipe at 261.66 feet, a total distance of 508.30 to a set iron pipe at the northeast corner of a proposed 11.869 acre tract and the <u>true</u> point of beginning;

Thence, with the line between the abovementioned Becker and Snyder; S 87 deg. 11' 11" E 2290.75 feet to a found iron pipe at the northerly corner of said 34.94 acre tract and a westerly corner of a 87.00 acre tract recorded in the name of Donald and Marjorie Becker;

Thence, with two lines of said 87.00 acre tract, S 26 deg. 44' 37" E 347.86 feet to a found iron pipe and S 46 deg. 55' 08" W 1276.67 feet to a set iron pipe in the northerly line of a 65.034 acre tract recorded in the name of James & Darlene Becker in Official Record 49, page 34;

Thence N 62 deg. 44' 56" W 719.57 feet to a found iron pipe;

Thence S 27 deg 43' 51" W 1098.10 feet to a found iron pipe;

Thence, N 67 deg. 12' 19" W 791.70 feet to a found iron pipe at the southeast corner of a 2.489 acre tract recorded in the name of Kathleen Ritchason in Deed Book 287, page 252.

Thence, with the easterly line of said Ritchason, N 20 deg. 01' 48" E, passing a found iron pipe at 335.05 feet, a total distance of 1055.81 feet to a set iron pipe;

Thence N 86 deg. 25' 14" W 27.56 feet to a set iron pipe;

Thence N 03 deg 05' 16" E 638.13 feet to the true point of beginning.

Beginning at a found iron spike in the centerline of Thomas Road(40' R/W), said spike being the original corner of the abovementioned 20.54 acre tract and now being the northwest corner of a 1.473 acre tract recorded in the name of Keith and Linda Beachy in Official Record 26, page 799 and the southwest corner of a 112.00 acre tract recorded in the name of Elizabeth and Roger Snyder in Deed Book 241, page 204;

Thence with the centerline of Thomas Road, S 03°37'11" W 248.00 feet to a found iron spike being the southwest corner of the aforesaid Beachy, and the true point of beginning;

Thence with the line between said Becker and Beachy, S 87°58'50" E 259.74 To a found iron pipe at the southeast comer of said Beachy:

Thence N 04°04'50" E 244.55 feet to a found iron pipe at the northeast corner of Beachy and in the southerly line of the abovementioned Snyder;

Thence with part of the line between said Snyder and Becker, S 87°11'11" E 246.64 feet to a set iron pipe;

Thence with a new division line of Becker, S 03°05'16" W 638.13 to a set iron pipe;

Thence S 86°25'14" E 27.56 feet to a set iron pipe:

Thence S 20°01'48" W 720.76 feet to a found iron pipe at the northwest corner of a 2.489 acre tract recorded in the name of Kathleen Ritchason in Deed Book 287, page 252;

Thence, with the northerly line of said Ritchason, N 81°41'02" W 175.92 feet to a found iron pipe at the southeast corner of a proposed 1.355 acre tract;

Thence, with two lines of said 1.355 acre tract, N10°23'55" E 260.49 feet to a found iron pipe and N 80°52'40" W 225.64 to a found P.K. nail in the centerline of Thomas Road;

Thence, with said centerline, N 10°15'00" E 269.40 feet to a found P.K. nail;

Thence, continuing with said centerline, N 03°37'11" E 511.91 to the <u>true</u> point of beginning.

The above described parcel contains 11.869 acres. Being 9.95 acres in V.M.S. 7528 and 1.92 acres in V.M.S. 12129. Iron pipes set are ¾" X 30" with caps stamped P.S. 7377.
