

## 7.768 Acres

The following description is for a parcel of land in the State of Ohio, County of Madison, Township of Scmerford, Virginia Military Survey Number 6014, and is part of a 170.642 acre tract and part of 58.186 acre tract recorded in the name of William and Ann Ward in Deed Book 270, pages 770 & 774, said parcel being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a found iron spike in the in the centerline of State Route 56(60' R/W), said spike being in the southerly line of said Ward and the northwesterly corner of a 7.322 acre tract recorded in the name of Richard Olsen in Deed Book 265, page 69;

Thence, with the centerline of State Route 56, N 37\*28'18" W(reference bearing in accordance with Deed Book 270, page 774) 711.75 feet to a point, said point being the <u>true</u> point of beginning:

Thence, continuing with said centerline, N 37°28'18" W 295.87 feet to a point;

Thence N 52°31'42" E, passing a set iron pipe at 30.00 feet, a total distance of 1121.94 feet to a found iron pipe;

Thence S 45"49'33" E 299.04 feet to a set iron pipe;

Thence S 52\*31'42" W, passing a set iron pipe at 1135.39 feet, a total distance of 1165.39 feet to the <u>true</u> point of beginning

The above described parcel contains 7.768 acres. Being 6.4216 acres from said 170.642 acre tract and 1.3464 acres form said 58.188 acre tract. Iron pipes set are 3/4" x 30" with caps stamped P.S.7377. The original plat of this survey, showing additional information, is on permanent file in the Madison County Tax Map Department.
