

Situated in the State of Ohio, County of Madison, City of London, located in Virginia Military Survey No. 5802, being part of that 16.990 acre tract of land described in the deed to London Truck & Tractor, Inc., recorded in Deed Book 285, Page 701 (record references to those of the Recorder's Office, Madison County, Ohio), and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pipe set (prior survey) in the northeasterly right-of-way line of Keny Boulevard (variable width R/W), at the southeasterly corner of that 0.8966 acre tract of land described in the deed to Speedway Superamerica LLC, recorded in Official Record 72, Page 1040;

thence northeasterly along the southeasterly line of said 0.8966 acre tract, North 36°49'00" East, 200.00 feet to an iron pipe set (prior survey) at the northeasterly corner of said 0.8966 acre tract;

thence southeasterly across said 16.990 acre tract, being along a line parallel with the northeasterly right-of-way line of said Keny Boulevard, South 65°38'47" East, 81.93 feet to an iron pipe set;

thence southwesterly through said 16.990 acre tract, being along a line parallel with the southeasterly line of said 0.8966 acre tract, South 36°49'00" West, 200.00 feet to an iron pipe set in the northeasterly right-of-way line of said Keny Boulevard;

thence northwesterly along said northeasterly right-of-way line of Keny Boulevard, North 65°38'47" West, 81.93 feet to the 'Point of Beginning,' containing 0.3673 acre of land, more or less, as surveyed and described in June of 1998, by Carl E. Turner, Jr., Registered Professional Surveyor No. 6702.

Subject, however, to all legal rights-of-way, of previous record.

The reference meridian for the foregoing description is based upon that meridian used for the Lafayette Street (U.S. Route 42) right-of-way plans (see Madison County, S.H. 241, Sec. D, Sheet 3 of 10), as witnessed by concrete monuments found 30 feet left of Station 40+00 & 45+00. Iron pipes called out as set, are 1" O.D., 30" in length, set flush with the ground, and capped with a yellow plastic plug inscribed "C. TURNER/P.S. 6702".
