Thence, with the centerline of Taylor-Blair Road North 17 deg. 40 min. 00 sec. West a distance of 200.00 feet to a mag nail set;

Thence, across said 20.001 acre tract the following two courses:

- 1) North 76 deg. 10 min. 12 sec. East, passing an iron pin and cap set at 25.06 feet, a total distance of 441.89 feet to an iron pin and cap set
- 2) South 09 deg. 44 min. 35 sec. East a distance of 200.06 feet to an iron pin and cap set in the north line of Troyer's 63.29 acre tract

Thence, with said line South 76 deg. 10 min. 12 sec. West, passing an iron pin and cap previously set at 390.51 feet, a total distance of 414.25 feet returning to the point of beginning containing 1.9610 acres more or less.

With the benefit of a 10 foot drainage easement said easement is tangent and 10 feet East of the East right-of-way line of Taylor-Blair Road and extends from the North line of the here-in-above described 1.9610 acre tract to the North line of said Hostetler's 20.001 acre tract and more particularly shown on the plat accompanying this legal description.

Beginning at a mag nail set in the centerline of Taylor-Blair Road (50 foot right-of-way) (County Road 14) said mag nail being at the northwest corner of said 20.001 acre tract

Thence, with Taylor-Blair Road the following two courses:

- 1) South 15 deg. 48 min. 32 sec. East a distance of 6.32 feet to a ½ inch iron pin found
- 2) South 17 deg. 40 min. 00 sec. West, passing a railroad spike found at the intersection of said centerline with the centerline of Gerwell Road (County Road 131) at 23.82 feet a total distance of 225.63 feet to a mag nail set at the true point of beginning;

Beginning at a mag nail previously set in the centerline of Taylor-Blair Road (50 foot right-of-way) (County Road 14) said mag nail being at the northwest corner of said 20.001 acre tract also being the southwest corner of a 104.999 acre tract conveyed to Helen A. Evans et.al. by Volume 268 Page 307 and also Volume 268 Page 309;

Thence, with the line between said 104.999 and 20.001 acre tract North 78 deg. 06 min. 19 sec. East, passing an iron pin and cap previously set at 24.38 feet, a total distance of 528.05 feet to an iron pin and cap set

Thence, across said 20.001 acre tract the following two new courses:

- 1) South 09 deg. 44 min. 35 sec. East a distance of 214.15 feet to an iron pin and cap set
- 2) South 76 deg. 10 min. 12 sec. West, passing an iron pin and cap set at 472.11 feet, a total distance of 497.17 feet to a mag nail set in the centerline of Taylor Blair Road

Thence, with said centerline North 17 deg. 40 min. 00 sec. West, passing a railroad spike found at the centerline intersection of said Taylor-Blair Road with the centerline of Gerwell Road (County Road 131) at 219.86 feet a total distance of 225.63 feet to a ½ inch iron pin found

Thence, continuing with said centerline North 15 deg. 48 min. 32 sec. West a distance of 6.32 feet returning to the point of beginning containing 2.6184 acres more or less, of which 0.3388 acres is in Canaan Township and 2.2796 acres is in Monroe Township.

Subject to a 10 foot drainage easement said easement is tangent to an 10 feet East of the East right-of-way line of Taylor Blair Road and extends from the South line of 2.0876 acre tract surveyed from Fred Hostetler by this surveyor June 23, 1999 to the North line of Hostetler's 20.001 acre tract and being more particularly shown on the plat accompanying this legal description.
